WHEREAS, Grady Hospital is facing mounting debt which may result in its closing, severely reducing the ability of the indigent, uninsured and underinsured to receive health services; and

WHEREAS, the closing of Grady Hospital would severely and negatively impact the economy and quality of life of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2007, the Grady Hospital Board convened a committee to study, for 60 days, a non-profit governance option that may enhance the financial position of Grady Hospital and its ability to provide health services in the region.
