

**A RESOLUTION BY

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A LIVABLE CENTERS INITIATIVE (LCI) GRANT FROM THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION (ARC) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$120,000), IN ORDER TO CONDUCT AN LCI STUDY FOR THE VINE CITY MARTA STATION ACTIVITY NODE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta participates in the Livable Communities Initiative (LCI) program sponsored by the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC); and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the LCI program is to define activity centers and corridors in local jurisdictions to help spur private and public investment in and adjacent to this centers; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has received notification from the ARC that funds are available for new LCI corridor studies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to apply for a grant from the ARC , in the amount of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,00) in order to conduct a LCI study for the Vine City MARTA Station Activity Center; and

**WHEREAS**, in the event that the City receives said grant, the ARC requires matching funds in the amount of Twenty Four Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$24,000); and

**WHEREAS**, the Councilmember for District 3 has identified matching funds for this study and will be provided from the Quality of Life Bond Program

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:**

**Section 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for a Livable Centers Initiative (LCI ) grant from the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) in an amount not to exceed \$120,000 for the Vine City MARTA Station activity node study.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the LCI will require matching funds in the amount of Twenty Four Thousand Dollars and No Cents (24,000)
