AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO FC-6040-94, AIRPORT RETAIL CONCESSIONS, WITH HOST/NATIONAL CONCESSIONS MANAGEMENT, LLC. (“HOST/NCM”), TO BE EFFECTIVE AS OF FEBRUARY 1, 2008 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2008, AUTHORIZING HOST/NCM TO PROVIDE, AND THE CITY TO ACCEPT AIRPORT RETAIL CONCESSIONS AT HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT UNDER THE TERMS SET FORTH IN CONTRACT FC-6040-94, AS AMENDED, BEGINNING FEBURARY 1, 2008 AND CONTINUING UNTIL THE CITY PROCURES AND EXECUTES A NEW AGREEMENT FOR AIRPORT RETAIL CONCESSIONS, BUT NOT TO EXTEND BEYOND APRIL 30, 2008; AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE SOURCE SELECTION REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN SECTION 2-1187, 2-1188, AND 2-1189 OF ARTICLE X, PROCUREMENT AND REAL ESTATE CODE, AS WELL AS ANY OTHER CONFLICTING PROVISIONS OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (the “City”), as owner and operator of the Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport (the “Airport”) entered into Concession Agreement FC-6040-94 (the “Lease”) with Host/NCM which became effective on April 1, 1995, for the establishment and operation of Airport retail concessions on Concourses B, C, D and T at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 07-O-1797, the City Council approved the extension of the Lease, on a month-to-month basis, through January 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, efforts to complete the procurement of retail concessions services are ongoing, and the Department of Aviation believes that the process will be completed by April 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Departments of Procurement and Aviation have determined that additional time will be required to ensure fairness and maximize competition in the procurement of new concessions; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City’s best interest to provide for the continuation of Airport retail concessions services until such time as the procurement of a new Airport retail concessions agreement has been completed; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation General Manager and Chief Procurement Officer have recommended that HOST/NCM be authorized to continue providing Airport retail concessions services, uninterrupted, and the City be authorized to accept such services, under the terms set forth in Contract FC-6040-94, as amended, until such time as a new contract for Airport retail concessions services has been procured and executed.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: That HOST/NCM is authorized to provide Airport retail concessions services, and the City is authorized to accept such services, under the terms set forth in FC-6040-94, as amended, beginning on February 1, 2008 and continuing until the earlier of: 1) the date the executes a new agreement for Airport retail concessions, 2) or April 30, 2008.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, including but not limited to Section 2-1187, 2-1188, and 2-1189 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances, are waived to the extent of the conflict.

Example: The task force of homelessness conducted a study regarding homelessness, its impact and consequences on the City. This resolution reflects the Mayor's desire to open a twenty-four hour center that will respond to the needs of the homelessness in Atlanta.

The City of Atlanta, and Host/NCM entered into an Agreement and Lease of Premises dated April 1, 1995, incorporating Amendments No. 1 through No. 3 (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Lease Agreement"), and uses certain premises and facilities in the Terminal Building and Concourses of the Central Passenger Terminal Complex at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport;

Resolution No. 96-R-0205 adopted February 19-27, 1996 and approved March 3, 1996 established the commencement date of the Lease Agreement as April 30, 1996 and increased the term of the Lease Agreement 250 days to account for unanticipated pre-Olympic construction cost and Resolution No. 01-R-1008 adopted July 16, 2001 and approved July 25, 2001 transferred The Charnel Company, Inc.'s rights, title, interest and liabilities in the Host/Charnel Joint Venture to National Concessions Management, LLC ("NCM") (Amendment No. 1);

Ordinance No. 00-O-0983 adopted August 7, 2000 and approved August 13, 2000 extended the lease agreement for one additional period of five (5) years and adjusted the method of calculating the Minimum Annual Guarantee (MAG) using the tenant's 1999 MAG as a base (Amendment No. 2);

Resolution No. 04-R-1312 adopted August 16, 2004 and approved August 25, 2004 amended the Lease Agreement in order to add 3,002 square feet (385 square feet at gate C24 and approximately 2,617 square feet at gate C15) of Exclusive Leased Premises on the Boarding Level of Concourse C to provide for expansion of Concessions operations for the benefit of passengers utilizing Concourse C (Amendment No. 3);

Amendment No.1 and Amendment No.2 incorporating the Lease Agreement established a ten year and 250 day term which determines the Lease Agreement expiration date as January 5, 2007;

Ordinance No 06-O2704 established the contract expiration date as August 31, 2007;

Ordinance 07-O-1997 approved by City Council September 4, 2007 extending the term of the Lease month to month through January 31, 2008 and increasing the percentage rental fee for news and gift stores to 17%.and all other stores to 15% with the exception of electronics 11%.
