**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 114, PERSONNEL, ARTICLE IV, CLASSIFICATION PLAN AND PAY PLAN OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, SO AS TO DELETE SEC. 114-120 COMPENSATION COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council adopted and the Mayor approved Ordinance 06-O-2700 creating a new Chapter 114, Personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 114-120 Compensation Committee of the new Chapter established the compensation committee comprised of the chief operating officer, chief financial officer and the commissioner of human resources, president of council and chair of the finance/executive committee to review personnel and other transactions as provided for in this Chapter or as deemed appropriate by the commissioner of human resources; and

**WHEREAS**, establishment of Section 114-120 removed oversight of certain personnel actions from the purview of the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, examples of personnel actions removed from Council oversight included review of position reclassifications, employee salary increases, above entry hiring authorizations and other actions; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to reinstate its oversight of personnel and other transactions as provided for in the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances Chapter 114 Personnel.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS as follows:**

**Section 1:** That Chapter 114-120 Compensation Committee, which currently reads as follows:

Sec. 114-120. Compensation committee.

There shall be an administrative board known as the compensation committee comprised of the chief operating officer, chief financial officer and the commissioner of human resources, president of council and chair of the finance/executive committee. The committee shall review personnel transactions as provided for herein and other transactions as deemed appropriate by the commissioner of human resources.

The commissioner of human resources shall provide to the city council prior notice of called meetings of the compensation committee. Within five (5) days after a meeting, the compensation committee shall provide to the city council a copy of the minutes of said meeting. The meetings of the compensation committee shall be subject to the Open Meetings Act.

Shall be amended by deleting in its entirety Section 114-120 Compensation Committee; and that Council oversight of personnel and other transactions as provided for in the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances Chapter 114 Personnel be reinstated.

**Section 2:** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances that are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are waived to the extent of the conflict.
