

AN ORDINANCE BY

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF THE NEW PEACHTREE-DUNWOODY PARK TO "LITTLE NANCY CREEK PARK" ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the new Peachtree-Dunwoody Park is a City of Atlanta owned park property located in Council District 7 in Northwest Atlanta, Georgia and the North Buckhead Civic Association desires to change the name of this park to "Little Nancy Creek Park"; and

WHEREAS, approximately 4.96 acres of property located at 3984, 3994 and 4012 Peachtree Dunwoody Road, N.W., Atlanta, Georgia has been sold to the City from The Conservation Fund in the amount of \$2,700,000.00 (PTAEO 13102847 PROJECT 101 TASK 350221103 AWARD 5411001 EXPENSE CITYWIDE GREENWAY TRAIL PROJECT) and purchasing this property is consistent with the City's goal of greenspace acquisition, preservation and park expansion; and

WHEREAS, the central geological feature of the new park is that it is bisected by Little Nancy Creek and the entire park is within the valley of Little Nancy Creek; and

WHEREAS, Little Nancy Creek originates in DeKalb County near the Oglethorpe University and flows through the middle of Brookhaven and through the middle of North Buckhead until it merges with Nancy Creek; and

WHEREAS, the North Buckhead Civic Association has approved of this name; and

WHEREAS, NPU-B was informed of the proposed name change, and specifically of the new name "Little Nancy Creek Park", and the NPU-B had no objections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ODRDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Atlanta Park currently known as Peachtree-Dunwoody Park shall be re-named the "Little Nancy Creek Park".

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed for the purposes of this Ordinance only, and only to the extent of the conflict.
