AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO ACCEPT A \$40,000 GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AND AMENDING THE 2009 (INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANT FUND) BUDGET, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION, AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS BY ADDING TO ANTICIPATIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$40,000.00) OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING AND IMPLEMENTING A PROGRAM FOR MENTORING AND TUTORING YOUNG GIRLS IN THE CITY OF ATLANTA (“CITY”); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs provides grant funds to organizations to establish tutoring and mentoring programs; and

WHEREAS, Georgia Department of Community Affairs awarded the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs a grant in the amount of \$40,000.00, to create and implement an After-School Program for the mentoring and tutoring of young girls between the ages of ten to fifteen residing within the Thomasville and Lakewood Heights communities; and

WHEREAS, the City will be reimbursed for all costs in creating and implementing the tutoring and mentoring program in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor, on behalf of the City of Atlanta, is authorized to accept a grant from the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in the amount of \$40,000 for the creation and implementation of an After-School Program that will mentor and tutor young girls between the ages of ten to fifteen residing within the Thomasville and Lakewood Heights Communities.
