

**A RESOLUTION  
BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/ HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE FULTON COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE FOR THE NEIGHBORHOOD FRESH START PROGRAM, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$48,562.29, TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND ACCOUNT AND CENTER NUMBER 1B01 (COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUND) 529002 (SERVICE GRANTS) Y46P0942A24A (NEIGHBORHOOD FRESH START, CD-753); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta ("City") is the recipient of grants from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to provide financial aid through the Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG"); and

**WHEREAS**, Fulton County District Attorney's Office is the sub-recipient of a CDBG grant in the amount of \$100,000, and on September 28, 2006, the City entered into an Agreement with Fulton County District Attorney's Office for property located at 3055 Delmar Lane, Atlanta, Georgia, as part of the Neighborhood Fresh Start Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract between the City and Fulton District Attorney's Office expired on December 31, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into another contract with Fulton District Attorney's Office, using remaining grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$48,562.29, for the cleaning and demolition of the property.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES**, that the Mayor is authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") with the Fulton County District Attorney's Office, in an amount not to exceed \$48,562.29, to be charged to and paid from 1B01 (Community Development Fund) 529002 (Service Grants) Y46P0942A24A (Neighborhood Fresh Start, CD-753), for the cleaning and demolition of property located at 3055 Delmar Lane, Atlanta, Georgia, as part of the Neighborhood Fresh Start Program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Attorney is directed to prepare an appropriate Agreement for execution by the Mayor.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Agreement will not become binding upon the City and the City will incur no obligation nor liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney and delivered to contracting parties.
