

**A RESOLUTION
BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS TO FUND THE HIGHWAY ENFORCEMENT OF AGGRESSIVE TRAFFIC AND THE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Highway Enforcement and Aggressive Traffic (H.E.A.T) program has led to a decline in accidents resulting in injuries and fatalities on roadways in the City of Atlanta ("City); and

WHEREAS, the City's Police Department desires to further reduce the number of accidents resulting in injuries and fatalities, including pedestrian injuries and fatalities on the City's roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety provides grants to promote safety on the roadways; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for a grant to fund the H.E.A.T and Pedestrian Safety program; and

WHEREAS, the grant money will be used toward officer salaries and supplies.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the Governor's Office of Highway Safety in an amount not to exceed two hundred fifty thousand six hundred dollars and zero cents (\$250,600.00) to fund the H.E.A.T and Pedestrian Safety programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this grant from the Governor's Office of Highway Safety will require a twenty percent (20%) match of \$50,200.00.
