

**A RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THAT THE  
MAYOR AUTHORIZE AN EVALUATION AND  
ANALYSIS OF THE FEASIBILITY OF  
ELIMINATING FLEET SERVICES AS A MEANS  
OF REDUCING THE COST OF THE 2009 BUDGET;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City is in the midst of an unprecedented \$140,000,000.00 shortfall in the 2009 General Fund Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Council is in the process of considering the Mayor's proposed 2009 Budget, and is interested in pursuing of initiatives that might decrease the cost of the Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, The City's Fleet Service Operation proposed 2009 Budget authorization is \$29,787,032; and

**WHEREAS**, The City's Fleet Service Operation is a City function which may be available for successful outsourcing and a means by which budget costs might be reduced; and

**WHEREAS**, an analysis of the fiscal impact of outsourcing Fleet Services on the City Budget is needed prior to consideration of proceeding with such an action.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that the Atlanta City Council submits to the Mayor a request that a study of the feasibility of outsourcing the City's Fleet Service Operation be conducted to determine the impact of such action on the 2009 and subsequent City Budgets.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**; that all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby waived.
