

A RESOLUTION BY

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAMS ART CONSERVATION FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE NOGUCHI PLAYSCAPE IN PIEDMONT PARK ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED (\$301,656.00); ALL FUNDS WILL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM THE ACCOUNT SEGMENT PTAE0 NUMBERS IDENTIFIED BELOW IN THE LEGISLATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") did solicit bids for the restoration of the Noguchi Playscape in Piedmont Park , on behalf of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Office of Cultural Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Cultural Affairs conducted an assessment in 2006 to determine the requirements and repair needs to restore the sculptural play elements that incorporate the Noguchi Playscapes. The assessment provided the basis for the development of a work plan that was advertised by procurement. The awarded contractor worked with the Office of Cultural Affairs to determine the scope of work and estimates for the required work; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs has recommended that the contract for the Restoration of the Noguchi Playscape in Piedmont Park be awarded to the most responsive and responsible bidder, Williams Art Conservation, 6234 Afton Place, Los Angeles, California 90028 for a period of five (5) months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Atlanta is authorized to enter into a contractual agreement with Williams Art Conservation for a duration of not more than five (5) months, in an amount not to exceed (\$301,656.00) for the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs.

SECTION 2. That the City Attorney be and is hereby directed to prepare the appropriate agreement for execution by the Mayor and the agreement shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney or her designee.

SECTION 3. That this agreement will not become binding upon the City and the City shall incur no obligation or liability hereunder until the same has been signed by the Mayor and attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to Williams Art Conservation.
