A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, IN ORDER TO SHARE FUNDS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, 2008 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$373,359.00), FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING POLICE EQUIPMENT AND FOR TRAINING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (“BJA”), offers grant funds to: (1) provide training and technical assistance to support law enforcement activities; (2) implement programs that improve the criminal justice system; and (3) conduct research to support law enforcement activities in state and local jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, BJA has announced that the City of Atlanta’s (“City”) Department of Police (“Department”) is eligible to apply for a Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”), in conjunction with Fulton County, Georgia (“County”), in the amount of three hundred seventy-three thousand, three hundred fifty-nine dollars (\$373,359.00); and

WHEREAS, the City and County wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (“Agreement”) which will specify the terms and conditions for the reallocation of the JAG funds (see attached as Exhibit “A”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the City agrees to pay the County a total of one hundred twelve thousand, seven dollars and seventy cents (\$112,007.70) of the JAG funds, and the City shall retain the remainder of the JAG funds in the amount of two hundred sixty-one thousand, three hundred fifty-one dollars and thirty cents (\$261,351.30); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an Agreement with the County in order to share the JAG funds for the purpose of purchasing police equipment and supplementing police programs.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES that the Mayor or her designee is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City of Atlanta (“City”), to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (“Agreement”) (see attached as Exhibit “A”) with Fulton County, Georgia (“County”), in order to share funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, 2008 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program (“JAG”), in the amount of three hundred seventy-three thousand, three hundred fifty-nine dollars (\$373,359).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City agrees to pay the County a total of one hundred twelve thousand, seven dollars and seventy cents (\$112,007.70) of the JAG funds, and the City shall retain the remainder of the JAG funds in the amount of two hundred sixty-one thousand, three hundred fifty-one dollars and thirty cents (\$261,351.30).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Agreement shall not become binding upon the City and the City shall incur no obligation or liability hereunder until the same has been approved as to form by the City Attorney, has been signed by the Mayor, attested to by the municipal clerk and delivered to the County.
