**AN AMENDED RESOLUTION BY  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT ("WIA") GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED NINETY FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY FOUR DOLLARS (\$294,674.00) FROM THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO PROVIDE TRAINING FUNDS FOR ADULTS WHO NEEDS TO UPGRADE OR ACQUIRE JOB SKILLS TO OBTAIN FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT AT LIVEABLE WAGES; ALL CONTRACTED WORK SHALL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM PTAE0 FUNDING SOURCE 250341770; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("Atlanta") administers special programs under contract to the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency ("AWDA"); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this legislation is to accept grant funds from the Georgia Department of Labor to provide training funds for adults who need to upgrade or acquire skills to obtain full-time employment; and

WHEREAS, this program is of great importance to the City by assisting customers who need to enhance job skills for future employment; and

WHEREAS, all contracted work shall be charged to and paid from PTAE0 Funding Source: 250341770.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES**, that the Mayor or her designee is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency a grant from the Georgia Department of Labor to help provided training funds for adults who need to upgrade or acquire skills to obtain full-time employment in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Ninety Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Four Dollars (\$294,674.00).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all contracted work shall be charged to and paid from PTAE0 Funding Source: 250341770.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that all resolutions or parts of resolutions that are in conflict herewith are hereby waived.
