COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY UNDER THE 2009 BROWNFIELD ASSESSMENT PROGRAM FOR HAZARDOUS AND PETROLEUM SITE PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF ATLANTA IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000.00); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has a pilot brownfield assessment grant that expires on September 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency is requiring for the 2009 program year that all local governments must compete for new grant awards beyond the September 30, 2009 deadline; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta recognizes that identification and remediation of brownfield sites is critical to new community and economic development efforts in the City and critical to the development of new greenspace sites throughout the City; and


WHEREAS, the City's Bureau of Planning proposes to submit a grant application for assessment of hazardous and petroleum sites; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit a grant application in an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for hazardous and petroleum site assessments as part of the 2009 brownfield assessment program.

SECTION 2: All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict are hereby rescinded.
