AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NUMER 08-O-1047 AND ORDINANCE # 08-0-1679 AND AMENDING THE 2009 (INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANT FUND) BUDGET, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE BY ADDING TO ANTICIPATIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS THE AMOUNT OF \$319,838.00 FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE WHITE HOUSE OFFICE OF NATIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY FOR CONTINUATION OF THE HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (HIDTA) TASK FORCE AND CONTINUE DISRUPTION OF DRUG TRAFFICKING ORGANIZATIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Police Department has been an active participant in the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) task force for the past ten years and

WHEREAS, the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (“White House”) grants funding to local task forces responsible for disrupting and dismantling violent drug trafficking organizations; and

WHEREAS, Department serves as the “pass through” agency to disburse payments for task force expenses that are completely federally funded; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance # 08-O-1047 amended the 2008 Intergovernmental Grant Fund Budget, Department of Police in the amount of four million, six hundred and ninety thousand, one hundred and ninety seven dollars (\$4,690,197.00 to continue funding HDTA task force initiatives and Ordinance # 08-O-1679 amended the 2008 Intergovernmental Grant Fund Budget Department of Police in the amount of four million eight hundred thirty nine thousand eight hundred and eight two dollars (\$4,839,882.00). The amended Ordinance # 08-O-1047 intended to add the supplemental amount of \$170,153.00 to the original grant award of \$4,520,044.00 and Ordinance # 08-O-1679 intended to correct the amount to total \$4,839,882.00 instead increased the grant amount by the grant total instead of adding supplemental amounts to the grant. By rescinding Ordinance # 08-O-1047 and rescinding Ordinance # 08-O-1679 and by supplementing the grant with the new Ordinance the grand total of the grant award to the City of Atlanta grant # 17GAP700Z is \$4,839,882.00.

WHEREAS, by rescinding Ordinance # 08-O-1047 and Ordinance # 08-O-1679 all grant award agreements to the City of Atlanta are in agreement. On April 5, 2007 the City of Atlanta was awarded \$4,520,044.00, on September 10, 2007 the award was amended by (4,847.00), September 21, 2007 the grant award was amended by \$175,000 and on May 6, 2008 (315.00) and on August 11, 2008 \$150,000.00 with the net grant award totaling \$4,839,882.00. This Ordinance will amend the amount of funds allocated in Oracle Financial System from \$9,210,241.00 to the correct grant award to four million eight hundred thirty nine thousand eight hundred and eighty two dollars (\$4,839,882.00) to continue funding HIDTA task force initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Department wishes to accept the said supplemental grant to continue funding the HIDTA task force.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance numbered 08-O-1047 be rescinded.

SECTION 2: That Ordinance numbered 08-O-1679 be rescinded.

SECTION 3: That the 2009 (Intergovernmental Grant Fund) Budget, Department of Police, is hereby amended as follows:

WHEREAS, the Department wishes to accept the said supplemental grant to continue funding the HIDTA task force.

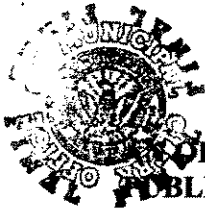

WHEREAS, Ordinance 07-O-1233 amended the 2007 Intergovernmental Grant Fund Budget, Department of Police in the amount of four million, five hundred twenty thousand, and forty-four dollars, (\$4,520,044.00), which was the original amount awarded to the Department by the White House;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 08-O-1047 increased the amount awarded by \$170,153.00 to a total amount of four million, six hundred and ninety thousand, one hundred and ninety-seven dollars (\$4,690,197.00) due to increased funding from the White House; and

WHEREAS, the White House has further increased the amount awarded by \$149,685.00 to a total amount of four million, eight-hundred and thirty-nine thousand, eight-hundred and eighty-two dollars (\$4,839,882.00) to continue funding HIDTA task force initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the Department wishes to accept the said supplemental grant to continue funding the HIDTA task force.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS, as follows:



SECTION 1: That the 2007 (Intergovernmental Grant Fund) Budget, Department of Police, is hereby amended as follows:


