BY THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL COMMITTEE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO DONATE THE EXISTING FIRE SAFETY HOUSE TO THE UNION COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT AS PART OF THE STIPULATION IN THE GRANT AGREEMENT WHEN AWARDED A NEW FIRE SAFETY HOUSE FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ON BEHALF OF THE ATLANTA FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Fire Rescue Department was recently awarded a new Fire Safety House from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the purpose of educating children on fire safety and prevention.

WHEREAS, the donation of the Fire Safety House will meet the requirements of the *2004 FEMA Project Safe Grant* which was awarded providing Atlanta Fire Rescue with a new Fire Safety House, and stipulates Atlanta Fire Rescue will in-tern donate its existing Fire Safety House to another Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Union County Fire Department was recommended to receive the Fire Safety House by the State of Georgia Fire Marshall's Office.

WHEREAS, the donation is made unconditionally and the City of Atlanta Fire Rescue Department relinquishes all interest in said property.

WHEREAS, the donated Fire Safety House is free from any liens, storage fees, or other related charges.

WHEREAS, upon acceptance of this equipment the Union County Fire Department will assume any and all liability in the future.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA GEORGIA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Mayor or her designee is hereby authorized to donate the existing Fire Safety House to the Union County Fire Department as stipulated in the grant agreement with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on behalf of the Atlanta Fire Rescue Department for the purpose of educating children on fire safety and prevention.
