**2. Transportation Sub-Committee Parking Enforcement Task Force Meeting Report
Councilmember Michael J. Bond, Chair**

Councilmember Michael J. Bond briefly announced that the next worksession of the Sub-Committee on parking Enforcement will meet on July 9, 2010 at 9:30am at City Hall. Councilmember Bond reported to the public that Councilmember Lance Bottoms' legislation on the legal issues surrounding the parking tickets that were issued by ParkAtlanta, passed on Monday June 21, 2010 and that Councilmember Hall's legislation (10-O-1163), and his own sponsored legislation (10-O-1227), is schedule to move forward by the July 19, 2010 Full Council meeting. He then asked Michael J. Cheyne, Interim Commissioner Public Works to come forward and report on the Parking Program Updates. The Commissioner reported that Category "A" has been completed and Category "B" recommendations are being dealt with and should be completed very soon. A report will be forth coming.

D. ORDINANCE FOR SECOND READING

10-O-1227 (1) An Ordinance by Councilmembers Michael Julian Bond, Kwanza Hall, Natalyn Archibong, Ivory Lee young, Jr., Cleta Winslow, Alex Wan, Keisha Lance Bottoms, Joyce M. Sheperd, C. T. Martin, H. Lamar Willis, Yolanda Adrean to amend Chapter 150, Article IV, Division 3, Section 150-132 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances to establish Metered Space Parking Zones throughout the City of Atlanta; to amend Chapter 150, Article IV, Division 1, by deleting Section 150-94 so as to eliminate the prohibition on Overnight Parking contained therein; to amend Chapter 150, Article IV, Division 1, Section 150-95 (a) so as to eliminate the prohibition of metered parking in excess of two hours in any business district including the Central Business District; and for other purposes.
