AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2010 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND) BUDGET IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS BY TRANSFERRING BETWEEN ACCOUNT THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$300,000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ALONG WIEUCA ROAD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Public Schools opened Sarah Smith Elementary School at 4141 Wieuca Road at the start of January 2010; and

WHEREAS, the safe movement of pedestrians from the surrounding neighborhoods to the School will require certain improvements including radar signs and sidewalks which will reduce conflicts between traffic flow and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, those system improvements have been identified in the capital improvement element of the City's Comprehensive Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 09-O-1879, certain funds were appropriated based on the City having a 60 foot right of way in which to construct these system improvements; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the field study and a detailed survey, the City has determined that a right-of-way in a segment of the roadway is only 40 feet; and

WHEREAS, the project is currently under construction and the additional funds to be appropriated by this ordinance are necessary for the completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the Atlanta Public Schools would agree to build the improvements as a part of their development of the School, the Departments of Planning and Community Development and Public Works would have agreed that these project improvements would qualify to be developer funded system improvements for which future transportation impact fee credits could be given; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Public Schools does not pay transportation impact fees to the City of Atlanta due to certain potential constitutional issues with the allocation of their ad valorem tax revenue for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, by the passage of this Ordinance, the governing authority will confirm that this project will be in proximity to certain fee paying projects which have generated development impact fees sufficient to fund these improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire additional permanent and temporary construction easements, including donation, if required, of the necessary rights-of-way from various property owners for roadway improvements for the Wieuca Road Sidewalk Improvements to be completed; and

WHEREAS, the system improvements to be financed will cause the service level of Wieuca Road to increase through better traffic control which will reduce the conflicts between traffic flow and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the reserve for development impact fees in the General Government Capital Outlay Fund Budget to provide the additional funding necessary to complete the project authorized by 09-O-1879.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1: That the 2010 (General Government Capital Outlay Fund) Budget is amended as follows:


