AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 150, ARTICLE IV, DIVISION 3, SECTION 150-132 ENTITLED "PARKING TIME LIMITS; FEES" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the current City Code limits the maximum time at parking meters to two hours; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works received a request from businesses and residents on Mitchell Street and other locations to increase parking meter time to three hours; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works needs to adjust time limit parking at parking meters from time to time to benefit users of the parking spaces.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, as follows:

Section 1: That chapter 150, article IV, division 3, section 150-132 of the code of ordinances currently provides as follows:

Sec. 150-132. Parking time limits; fees.

(a) The period of time of parking in areas designated as parking meter zones shall be registered by mechanical parking meters, and the charges which are reasonably necessary to defray the expenses incident thereto for this parking shall be as set out in subsection (b) of this section.

(b) Such meters shall provide for maximum time limits as indicated on each meter, of either 12 minutes, 30 minutes, one hour or two hours. The fee in each instance shall be at the rate of \$1.00 per half an hour of time allowed.

(c) Vehicles which have purchased a currently valid truck loading zone/parking meter pass pursuant to Atlanta City code section 150-111 (c) shall be permitted to park at all parking meter spaces in the city of Atlanta without charge for a period not to exceed the maximum time limit indicated on each meter or 30 minutes, whichever is more.

Section 2: That chapter 150, article IV, division 3, section 150-132 (b) of the code of ordinances be amended allowing the mayor or his designee set time limit at parking meters as follows.

(a) The period of time of parking in areas designated as parking meter zones shall be registered by parking meters, and the charges which are reasonably necessary to defray the expenses incident thereto for this parking shall be as set out in subsection (b) of this section.

(b) Such meters shall provide for maximum time limits as indicated on each meter where the maximum time limit at parking meters shall be determined by Department of Public Works. The fee in each instance shall be at the rate of \$1.00 per half an hour of time allowed.



(c) Vehicles which have purchased a currently valid truck loading zone/parking meter pass pursuant to Atlanta City code section 150-111 (c) shall be permitted to park at all parking meter spaces in the city of Atlanta without charge for a period not to exceed the maximum time limit indicated on each meter or 30 minutes, whichever is more.

Section 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
