... outgoing auto were gone since the arrest of Jonathan Dodd from embezzling a large amount of the City's money until the year 2002:

- ① Retaliatory, false claims regarding my character and work ethics to cover up ongoing money laundering activities within the City of Atlanta.
- ② My vehicle, that I recently drove from Colorado, was illegally towed from a legal parking space that did not display a no parking sign on the day I parked.
- ③ In contacting the towing company (PJ Towing), Paul informed me that I would need to turn over my title to retrieve a few things or pay \$194 dollars for having my vehicle for 1 day.
- ④ I was, consequently forced to continue to stay in Atlanta and reside in shelters with my 13 year old daughter and my identical twin sister - Tamica (who also used to work during the same period as a computer technician for the City of Atlanta).
- ⑤ In staying in Gateway (established by Mayor Shirley Franklin and the United Way), I was denied resources in the form of emergency assistance to include: ① housing ② job assistance ③ transportation assistance ④ information/referrals to entities who were readily available and desiring to help.
- ⑥ I was repeatedly told wrong information intentionally by Gateway staff who were intentionally trying to do things to attempt to discredit me as a viable witness to the ongoing money laundering activities that I observed and reported that are happening at this Gateway Center.
- ⑦ My outgoing communication and travel (without a car) was hindered and blocked to the degree that my family and I were unjustifiably discharged from the one place we were referred to by Gateway because I walked to my place of employment to get a verification of employment signed.
- ⑧ I have had officers to intentionally deny me assistance regarding reporting incidents because of lies initiated by Staff.
