RESOLUTION

BY: COUNCILMEMBERS YOLANDA ADREAN, ALEX WAN, KWANZA HALL

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE MAYOR TAKES INTO CONSIDERATION AND FUNDS PRIORITIES THAT THE ATLANTA CITY COUNCIL RECOMMENDS BEING INCLUDED IN THE 2011 BUDGET; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 6-302 of the Atlanta City Charter provides authorization to the Mayor to prepare and submit the proposed Annual Budget Ordinance to the governing body; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 05-O-1976, Adopted as Amended by City Council on November 21, 2005 further provides that the Atlanta City Council will submit via resolution its priorities to the Mayor for consideration in the preparation of the Tentative Budget for the upcoming year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Atlanta City Council submits to the Mayor for consideration and inclusion in the 2011 Budget, the priorities listed:

Atlanta City Council 2011 Budget Priorities

- No Millage rate increase for property owners
- Identify sources of cash/revenue to include sales of assets, including divestiture of city jail and City Hall East, aggressive pursuit of receivables and sales tax (MOST) We will have a full study and evaluation of other City assets
- Sustainable plan for a pension plan for existing and new employees
- Adopt the Five Year Plan once it has been adjusted to fully disclose all infrastructure needs. This can be achieved by adding an addendum. Many of the infrastructure needs are discussed but not all are included.
- More funding for code enforcement
- To maintain or reduce the 2009/2010 spending levels
- Create a Master Economic Development Plan
- Prepare a plan to spend MOST Funds if approved



Develop a permanent Economic development Council think tank

- Provide increased compensation for all employees
- Increase sworn APD police officers
- Re-open recreation center across city (expense neutral)
- Increase staff/support for City solicitor and Public Defender
- Increase frequency of street/right of way cleaning
- Council having its own Attorney(s) and Finance Person
- Eliminate non-core City functions/services
- Reduce the City's dependence on property and sales taxes as a percentage of General Fund revenue and increase its capacity to access state, federal, and philanthropic funding

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
