

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MATTIE'S CALL TEAM ATLANTA DURING EACH ANNUAL ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATION MEMORY WALK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

- WHEREAS,** Someone is diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease every 70 seconds in the U.S.; and
- WHEREAS,** Alzheimer's disease is the sixth-leading cause of death for people in the United States and the fifth-leading cause of death for those over the age of 65; and
- WHEREAS,** Alzheimer's disease affects 5.2 million Americans today with nearly 200,000 people battling the disease in the state of Georgia alone (over 60,000 in metro Atlanta); and
- WHEREAS,** The number of Americans with Alzheimer's disease will continue to grow – by 2050 the number of individuals with Alzheimer's could range from 11.3 million to 16 million; and
- WHEREAS,** A Gallup poll commissioned by the Alzheimer's Association found that 1 in 10 Americans said that they had a family member with Alzheimer's and 1 in 3 knew someone with the disease; and
- WHEREAS,** Alzheimer's disease is expected to triple by the middle of the century, due to baby boomers and an increased life expectancy, making the annual cost of the disease soar to at least \$375 billion; and
- WHEREAS,** The cost to U.S. businesses due to Alzheimer's disease is over \$61 billion per year; and
- WHEREAS,** 79% of every dollar raised by the Alzheimer's Association, Georgia Chapter, is used to fund local programs and services; and
- WHEREAS,** The Alzheimer's Association Memory Walk® is the nation's largest event to raise awareness and funds for Alzheimer care, support and research. Since 1989, Memory Walk has raised more than \$300 million for the cause; and



WHEREAS,

Memory Walk is a community event that joins friends, family and co-workers as they walk to end Alzheimer's. Participants typically register in teams of 10-12 and fundraise using tools supported by the Alzheimer's Association. Walks vary from one to three miles and are held in nearly 600 locations nationwide; and

WHEREAS,

Mattie's Call Atlanta was originally formed in 2004 to raise money, walk and donate to Memory Walk.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Atlanta City Council Supports the Alzheimer's Association Memory Walk held annually in Atlanta.

SECTION: 2 That the Atlanta City Council supports any team effort made by members of Council and/or employees of the City.

SECTION: 3 That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
