JOE HINDSLEY

Joe Hindsley is a graduate of Penn State University with a degree in Hotel Restaurant Management. He began his career with Hyatt Hotels in 1982 being recruited into the company's Corporate Management Training program.

Over the past 28 years, Joe has steadily moved up through the Hyatt management structure. He was promoted to General Manager of the 1260-room Hyatt Regency Atlanta in March of 2004. Prior to arriving in Atlanta, he was the General Manager of the 539-room Hyatt Regency St. Louis and was previously the General Manager of the 312-room Hyatt Lisle, IL. Joe was nominated for Hyatt's prestigious Donald N. Pritzker Award as General Manager of the Year in 2001 and 2002.

Since arriving in Atlanta, Joe became a member of the Rotary Club of Atlanta. He is the Vice Chair of the Atlanta Convention and Visitor's Bureau. He has also been appointed by Atlanta Mayor Shirley Franklin to the Atlanta Work Force Development Board and now serves as Chairman on the Board. He serves on the Board of Directors of Central Atlanta Progress/Atlanta Downtown Improvement District.

Joe is a charter member of the Atlanta Police Foundation and was recognized by the Fulton County Police Chief George Coleman as an Honorary Officer. Joe has also been awarded "General Manager of the Year" by the Concierge Society of Atlanta and Georgia Hotel and Lodging Association. In 2007, Secretary of State, Karen Handel, honored Joe as an Outstanding Georgia Citizen.

Joe is currently the Vice Chair of the downtown Atlanta Hotel Council. He was the driving force in establishing the "Adopt a Fire House" program. Its purpose is to build a positive partnership with the local downtown hotels and Atlanta Fire Rescue. Through this program, hotels in the downtown area have "adopted" a fire station nearest their location. They provide meals to the firefighters on duty during the holidays, have renovated several firehouses and assisted with the distribution of smoke detectors to the elderly & disabled. Fire Chief Dennis Rubin recognized Joe as an Honorary Fire Chief.

Under Joe's leadership, the hotel has been recognized by several local organizations. Both Who's Who of Black Atlanta and the Georgia Hispanic Chamber of Commerce recognized Hyatt Regency Atlanta as Corporation of the Year. The City of Atlanta presented Hyatt Regency Atlanta with the 2007 Phoenix Award for Outstanding Corporate Citizenship. Georgia Meeting Professionals International (GaMPI) recognized Hyatt Regency Atlanta as Facility of the Year. The American Institute of Architects nominated Hyatt Regency Atlanta as one of the architectural icons built between 1966 and 1975. Successful Meetings Magazine awarded Hyatt Regency Atlanta the 2007 Pinnacle Award. Hyatt Regency Atlanta also received the prestigious 2007 Trail Blazer award from the Atlanta Business League.

Joe currently resides in Alpharetta with his wife of twenty-four years, Lisa, and their children Katelyn 21, Jennifer 20, and Joey 16.
