AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN ARTICLE X OF THE PROCUREMENT AND REAL ESTATE CODE OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR PARSONS/EGM, JV, FOR FC-7568-03, PROGRAM AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE QUALITY OF LIFE BOND PROGRAM, BY EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2010 AND PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIX HUNDRED NINETY NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY FOUR DOLLARS AND THIRTY THREE CENTS (\$699,674.33); ALL CONTRACTED WORK SHALL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM VARIOUS FUND, DEPARTMENT, ACCOUNT AND CENTER NUMBERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**AN ORDINANCE BY
FINANCE/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN ARTICLE X OF THE PROCUREMENT AND REAL ESTATE CODE OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR PARSONS/EGM, JV, FOR FC-7568-03, PROGRAM AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE QUALITY OF LIFE BOND PROGRAM, BY EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2010 AND PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO THE SIXTH TERM OF THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIX HUNDRED NINETY NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY FOUR DOLLARS AND THIRTY THREE CENTS (\$699,674.33); ALL CONTRACTED WORK SHALL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM VARIOUS FUND, DEPARTMENT, ACCOUNT AND CENTER NUMBERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") did enter into agreement with Parsons/US Infrastructure, JV for FC-7568-03, Program and Construction Management Services for the Quality of Life Bond Program; and

WHEREAS, the base term of the agreement is for five (5) years which expired April 18, 2009, with one (1), one (1) year renewal option at the sole discretion of the City; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 04-R-0139 Program and Construction Management Services for the Quality of Life Bond Program was adopted by the City Council on February 2, 2004 and approved by the Mayor on February 10, 2004 in the amount of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$550,000.00); and

WHEREAS, this agreement provides that compensation limits for the second and subsequent years be established annually by the Department of Public Works, subject to the approval of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-R-1339 was adopted by the City Council on August 15, 2005 and approved by the Mayor on August 22, 2005 to provide compensation for the second term in the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Fifty Four Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Four Dollars and Sixty Six Cents (\$1,854,284.66); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 06-R-2064 was adopted by the City Council on October 2, 2006 and approved per Section 2-403 of City Charter on October 11, 2006, to provide compensation for the third term in the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Fifty One Thousand Sixty Four Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$1,851,064.13); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 07-R-1374 was adopted by the City Council on July 16, 2007 and approved by the Mayor on July 19, 2007 to provide compensation for the fourth term



in the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Ninety Four Thousand Seven Hundred One Dollars and Three Cents (\$1,894,701.03); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 08-R-1276 was adopted by the City Council on July 7, 2008 and approved by the Mayor on July 14, 2008 to enter into Renewal Agreement No. 1 and to provide compensation for the fifth term in the amount of One Million Three Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand One Hundred Sixty Six Dollars and Ninety One Cents (\$1,357,166.91); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 09-R-1318 was adopted by the City Council on August 17, 2009 and approved by the Mayor on August 25, 2009 to provide compensation for the sixth term in the amount of Eight Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars and Two Cents (\$853,612.02); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer authorized a ninety (90) day extension on February 5, 2010 giving a new expiration date of July 17, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Parsons/US Infrastructure, JV has become Parsons/EGM PCMT, JV; and

WHEREAS, Parsons/EGM PCMT, JV has performed the contracted services satisfactorily to the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the compensation rates have been reset for the extended dates of the sixth term; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to amend the existing compensation limits to the sixth term of the contract by adding additional funds to the contract in an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Four Dollars and Thirty Three Cents (\$699,674.33) and extending the term of the contract until December 31, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend amending the sixth term of the contract to help offset past reductions in force allowing for the continued level of support with Program and Construction Management Services for the Quality of Life Bond Program.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the Article X of the Procurement and Real Estate Code of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances is waived for program and construction Management Services for the Quality of Life Bond Program with Parsons/EGM, Joint Venture.

SECTION 2 That the compensation limits for the sixth term of FC-7568-03, Program and Construction Management Services for the Quality of Life Bond Program be amended to add additional funds to reset the rates and to extend the term of the contract



until December 31, 2010 to support the continuation of program and construction management services for the Quality of Life Bond Program in an amount not the exceed Six Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Four Thousand and Thirty Three Cents (\$699,674.33).

SECTION 3. That the City Attorney is directed to prepare an appropriate agreement for execution by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. That the agreement shall not become binding upon the City and that the City shall incur no obligation or liability hereunder, until the same has been approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk and delivered to Parsons/EGM PCMT, JV.

SECTION 5.
