AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A 30-DAY MORATORIUM ON THE PROVISION OF PARKING METER ENFORCEMENT AND INSTALLATION CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO FC-4877 PARKING MANAGEMENT SERVICES, ON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF ATLANTA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”) entered into FC-4877 Parking Management Services (“Agreement”) with Duncan Solutions, Inc., d/b/a PARKAtlanta (“PARKAtlanta”) on September 24, 2009, authorizing the provision of parking management services, including infrastructure installation and management, parking meter enforcement, electronic filing and post filing services; and

WHEREAS, PARKAtlanta began operation of Parking Management Services in November 2009, assuming the responsibility for the management of parking meter enforcement, including the issuance of parking citations; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement authorizes PARKAtlanta to enforce parking regulations at 2,500 metered parking spaces previously designated and approved by the City, in residential permit parking areas and other places; and

WHEREAS, the provision of Parking Management Services in areas which have traditionally experienced little or inconsistent parking enforcement has affected Atlanta area residents, business owners, and university students; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Agreement to date has caused an increased number of complaints from those most affected by the issuance of citations pursuant to parking enforcement efforts; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to suspend the issuance of parking citations and the installation of all meters not currently installed for a finite time period to assess the policies and practices of parking enforcement pursuant to the Agreement that is both consistent and transparent to the public; and



WHEREAS, there is a likelihood that the suspension of the issuance of parking citations pursuant to the Agreement will result in the reassessment of fees due to the City from PARKAtlanta under the terms of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, a 30-day moratorium on the provision of parking enforcement conducted pursuant to the Agreement in the corporate boundaries of the City of Atlanta will allow the City to assess the policies and practices of parking enforcement under the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1: That a city-wide 30-day moratorium of parking enforcement of metered parking spaces and the installation of all parking meters not currently installed pursuant to FC-4877 Parking Management Services between the City of Atlanta and Duncan Solutions, Inc., d/b/a PARKAtlanta (“PARKAtlanta”), shall be and is hereby imposed, effective at 12:00 a.m. on May 12, 2010 and lasting through 11:59 p.m. on June 10, 2010.

SECTION 2: That the moratorium of parking enforcement authorized in SECTION 1 herein shall not be understood or implied to prohibit parking enforcement conducted by members of the Atlanta Police Department.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor or his designee direct the Department of Public Works to utilize the moratorium period to assess the policies and practices of parking enforcement and administration pursuant to the Agreement that may include enhanced customer service training, ongoing public education and involvement and administrative directions to PARKAtlanta that reduce the number of citizen complaints.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby waived to the extent of such conflict only.
