

A RESOLUTION BY:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL CLERK TO PLACE A PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION DEPICTING THE TAX DIGEST MILLAGE RATE, TAX LEVY AND OTHER INFORMATION REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 48-5-32 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Section 6-302 of the Charter of the City of Atlanta (“City”) requires the governing body of the City to adopt by ordinance an annual budget for the ensuing fiscal year, not later than June preceding the commencement of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Section 6-302 of the Charter of the City requires that the total appropriation for any fund shall not exceed the estimated fund balance, reserves, and revenues constituting the fund availability of such fund; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Section 6-301 of the Charter of the City requires the Budget Commission to annually prepare and file with the governing body for submission to the Mayor the budget revenue anticipations for the City; and

WHEREAS, the budget revenue anticipations submitted by the Budget Commission cannot be altered by the governing body; and,

WHEREAS, Section 48-5-32 of the Official Code of Georgia (“O.C.G.A.”) requires that a report be published in a newspaper of general circulation throughout the county at least two weeks prior to the establishment of the millage rate for ad valorem taxes for purposes other than educational purposes for the current calendar year; and

WHEREAS, Section 9-38 of the City Code also requires the advertisement of a notice of intent to increase property taxes in those instances in which the City proposes to establish an y millage rate which would require increases beyond the roll-back rate; and

WHEREAS, the notice pursuant to O.C.G.A. 48-5-3211(b)(2) and Section 9-38 of the City Code requires that the City tentatively adopt the millage rate that will result in increases beyond the roll-back tie; and

WHEREAS, the tentative adoption of the proposed millage rate in no way precludes the City Council of the City from finally adopting a different millage rate; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a public advertisement, based on the 2010 Tax Digest, to be advertised in a newspaper of general circulation and has prepared a millage rate ordinance to be adopted by Council in accordance with O.C.G. A. 48-5-32; and



THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES that the City Council of the City tentatively adopts the millage rate solely for the purpose of beginning the requisite process of advertising and conducting public hearings to allow public input prior to establishing the final millage rate, which may be different than the tentatively adopted rate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City shall finally adopt the millage rate after the conclusion of the public hearings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Municipal Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to place a public advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation depicting the tax digest, tentative millage rate, ad valorem taxes and such other information required by O.C.G.A. 48-5-32.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public advertisement shall be placed in a prominent location in such newspaper and shall not be included with the legal advertisements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all funds for this service should be charged to and paid from

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the above-mentioned information shall be broadcast on City Cable TV Channel 26.
