**AN ORDINANCE
BY COUNCILMEMBER KWANZA HALL**

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PERMIT ON-STREET PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF AUBURN AVE BETWEEN JACKSON ST. AND BOULEVARD ON SUNDAYS BETWEEN 7 AM AND 2 PM.; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the church leadership in the community has requested that changes be made to the “on street parking” for Sundays along Auburn Avenue between Jackson and Boulevard Streets; and

WHEREAS, this request is made in light of the City’s recent outsourcing of parking enforcement and the Church’s desire to alleviate potential inconvenience of its members; and

WHEREAS, permitting Vehicular Parking on both sides of Auburn Ave. between Jackson and Boulevard on Sundays between 7 am and 2 pm would meet the parking needs of churches in the area.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to permit Vehicular Parking on both sides of Auburn Ave between Jackson St. and Boulevard on Sundays between 7 am and 2 pm.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to install appropriate signage indicating Vehicular Parking on both sides of Auburn Ave between Jackson St. and Boulevard on Sundays between 7 am and 2 pm.

SECTION 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby waived in this instance only.
