**AN ORDINANCE BY  
TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 7, SUBDIVISION VII, SECTIONS 22-301 AND 22-302 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION GROUND TRANSPORTATION DIVISION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLYING WITH FEDERAL LAW REVISIONS AFFECTING THOSE SECTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta (“City”) owns and operates Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport (“Airport”); and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 22, Article III, Division 7, Subdivision VII, Section 22-301 (“§22-301”) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlanta, sets forth the conditions under which the Aviation General Manager may issue a limousine permit to any person desiring to operate a limousine at the Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 22, Article III, Division 7, Subdivision VII, Section 22-302 (“§22-302”) requires limousine drivers and operators to wear a visible identification badge at all times while at the Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Security Administration (“TSA”) issued Directive 1542-04-08F (“Directive”), requiring all airport operators to verify the identity and work authorization; to complete a 10-year FBI-based Criminal History Records Check (“CHRC”) and a TSA-issued Security Threat Assessment (“STA”) for anyone requesting identification media issued or requesting access to an airport’s Security Identification Display Area (“SIDA”), Sterile Area or air operations area (“AOA”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Directive added general requirements for airport operators which are not currently part of 22-301 and 22-302; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is required to comply with federal regulations and this Directive and desires to amend 22-301 and 22-302 in order to do so.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE:** That Chapter 22, Article III, Division 7, Subdivision VII, Section 22-301, which currently reads as follows:



Section 22-301 – Permit.

- (2) d. 6 During a period of five years immediately prior to the date of application the violation of any of the following criminal offenses of the state or any other state or of the United States: criminal homicide, rape, aggravated battery, mayhem, burglary, aggravated assault, kidnapping, robbery, child molestation, criminal solicitation to commit any of such offenses, criminal attempt to commit any of such offenses, any felony in the commission of which a motor vehicle was used, perjury or false swearing in making any statement under oath in connection with the application for a driver's permit, any law involving violence or theft, and sale or distribution of narcotic drugs, barbituric acid derivatives and/or central nervous system stimulants, provided, however, that all applicants shall be entitled to the full benefits of O.C.G.A. tit. 42, ch. 8, art. 3 (O.C. G.A. § 42-8-60 et seq.), the first offender act.



**SECTION TWO:** That Chapter 22, Article III, Division 7, Subdivision VII, Section 22-302, which currently reads as follows:

**Section 22-302 – Operating conditions.**

- (e) Every limousine driver and every other representative of a limousine operator at the airport shall wear a photo identification badge visible to others at all times, showing the individual's name and the limousine company's name. Such badge shall be obtained from the aviation general manager, with the production cost thereof to be paid by the company or its representative or driver.



be amended to:

- (e) Every limousine driver and every other representative of a limousine operator at the airport shall wear an **airport issued** identification badge visible to others at all times, showing the individual's name and the limousine company's name. Such badge shall be obtained from the **security badge office**, with the production cost thereof to be paid by the company or its representative or driver. **Drivers must successfully complete a FBI based Criminal History Records Check and security threat assessment in accordance with Transportation Security Administration Regulation 1542 and applicable security directives.**

**SECTION THREE:** That all existing Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith shall be waived to the extent of the conflict.
