**A RESOLUTION BY  
TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT LOCAL FUNDS FROM THE METROPOLITAN ATLANTA RAPID TRANSIT AUTHORITY ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROJECTS AROUND MARTA STATIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVEN MILLION SIX HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$7,649,680.00); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta (“City”) wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (“MARTA”) to accept local funds obtained through sales taxes levied by MARTA pursuant to the MARTA Act and the Rapid Transit Contract and Assistance Agreement, for the design and construction of several transit enhancement projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Atlanta Regional Commission (“ARC”) agreed to commit these funds to MARTA and, in exchange, MARTA has committed to fund qualified projects contained in the region’s Transportation Improvement Plan (“TIP”) from MARTA’s capital budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has projects which are approved and contained in the Transportation Improvement Plan and deemed as eligible to receive funding from MARTA’s capital budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s share of funding from MARTA for these qualified projects is in an amount of Seven Million Six Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$7,649,680.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the City has identified ADA curb ramp upgrades, pedestrian accessibility and safety improvement projects around MARTA stations and bus route corridors as pre-qualified transportation improvement projects to receive local MARTA funds as the city’s share.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (“MARTA”) for the acceptance and administration of local funds for Transportation Improvement Projects around MARTA stations and bus route corridors in the amount of Seven Million Six Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$7,649,680.00).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Attorney be and hereby is directed to prepare appropriate agreements for execution by the Mayor or his designee.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to accept local funds from MARTA for the design and construction of ADA curb ramp upgrades, pedestrian accessibility and safety improvement projects around MARTA stations and bus route corridors.



**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that this Agreement shall not become binding on the City and the City shall incur no liability upon the same until the Agreement has been approved as to form by the City Attorney, executed by the Mayor or his designee, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority.
