Vita of Lydia Tucker Arnold

Lydia Tucker Arnold is a native Atlantan, educated in the public schools of Atlanta, Georgia. She received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Elementary Education from Clark-Atlanta University, 1961 and her Masters Degree in Religious Education from The Interdenominational Theological Center, 1963.

While matriculating at Clark College, Mrs. Arnold was a member of various student organizations. She joined the ranks of other women as a member of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority. Lydia was also elected as secretary of the student body in 1959, which led to her becoming a founding member of the Committee On Appeal For Human Rights.

This committee led boycotts and picket lines that resulted in the desegregation of public accommodations in the City of Atlanta. While in high school, Lydia was president of the youth chapter of the NAACP.

Mrs. Arnold's first job was with Bethel A.M.E. Church in Detroit, Michigan as Director of Religious Education. Other areas of employment include the Atlanta Urban League as a housing counselor, and Sales Manager at the Atlanta Convention and Visitors Bureau from which she retired.
