



**A RESOLUTION BY:
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT ON BEHALF OF THE ATLANTA CITY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS (ACDC) COMPENSATION IN AN AMOUNT NO GREATER THAN \$15,000.00 (FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS) PER YEAR FROM THE MOREHOUSE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING AND DELIVERY OF AN ON-SITE AND/OR COMMUNITY BASED HIV RISK REDUCTION INTERVENTION PROGRAM TAILORED TO THE RAPID RELEASE NATURE OF THE PRETRIAL DETAINEE POPULATION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the ACDC on the 1st day of April, 2010, entered into a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with Morehouse School of Medicine ("MSM") for the purpose of its research study "Prevention Intervention: Meeting Them At The Gate" (PIMTAG), and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said study is to learn about changes in sexual activity and drug/alcohol use when a post arrest and detained adult male returns to areas with high HIV rates and for the assessment of services necessary for this transition; and

WHEREAS, the objective of this study is to afford the participants an opportunity of lessening their chances of getting HIV and abusing drugs/alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the ACDC for their part agrees to provide:

- recruitment services as part of their normal medical and mental health screening intake procedures
- office space and equipment,
- a phone line,
- and access to the Atlanta City Detention Center's adult African American men 22 years and older with a history of substance abuse who are sexually active; and

WHEREAS, the ACDC will remain in compliance with HIPAA Laws by not sharing medical information received from subjects with "MSM" and by getting clients' consent to be considered for the PIMTAG study.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA AS FOLLOWS:

The Mayor or his designee allows the Atlanta City Department of Corrections to accept compensation in the amount of \$15,000.00 (fifteen thousand dollars and no cents) from Morehouse School of Medicine for the purpose of conducting a research study on changes in sexual activity and drug/alcohol use of post arrest and detention males returning to areas with high HIV rates. Said funds will be deposited into **7701** (Fund), **090201** (Department), **3423001** (Account), **3420000** (Function), **600270** (Project), **69999** (Funding Source).

Memorandum of Understanding

This letter of agreement is being entered into by and between Morehouse School of Medicine, with its principle place of business at 1513 East Cleveland Avenue, Building #100, 2nd Floor, Suite 250-B, East Point, GA 30344 (hereinafter referred to as "MSM") and Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center, 236 and 254 Peachtree Street, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303 (hereinafter "Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center") and is effective April 1, 2010, upon execution by both parties. This Memorandum of Understanding shall hereinafter be referred to as "MOU," Memorandum, or Memorandum of Understanding.

Purpose:

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to guide and direct the parties in respecting their affiliation and working relationship. Principal objectives shall be to:

- Enter into a collaborative relationship for the development and delivery of an on-site and/or community based HIV risk reduction intervention tailored to the rapid release nature of the pre-trial detainee population.

Term:

This MOU shall commence on April 1, 2010 and end March 31, 2011. Thereafter the term shall be automatically renewed on an annual basis. MSM or Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center may terminate this arrangement at any time by giving thirty (30) days written notice.

Model Delivery:

The Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center and MSM will work collaboratively under the project framework which has been reviewed by the Morehouse School of Medicine Institutional Review Board (IRB). The IRB, also known as an independent ethics committee, is a committee that has been formally designated by the Food and Drug Administration and the Department of Health and Human Services to approve monitor and review studies involving humans with the aim of protecting the rights and welfare of the research participants.

Populations to be served under this agreement shall include adult African American men 22 years and older, with a history of substance use, sexually active, and are classified as medium to low security pre-trial jail status. The Morehouse School of Medicine will require the use of their study laptops to administer study assessment questionnaires and to assist in the delivery of the bi-weekly 90-minute trainings.



Responsibilities:

- (A) The MSM research team will provide 90 minute bi-weekly on-site facilitated small group HIV risk reduction intervention modules to those participants who are in the custody of the Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center using laptops, LCD projectors, tape recorders, and booklets.
- (B) The Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center shall provide study recruitment services as part of their normal medical and mental health screening intake procedures.
- (C) The Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center shall provide office space and equipment, a phone line, and access to the Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center adult African American men 22 years and older with a history of substance abuse and sexual active.
- (D) See attached research protocol for detail screening and recruitment procedures.

Resource Commitments:

Conditions for provision for services include continued funding and the adherence to all other terms of this memorandum.

Implementation:

The MSM research team will provide 90 minute bi-weekly on-site facilitated small group HIV risk reduction intervention modules to those participants who are in the custody of the Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center in an effort to reduce the behavioral risk associated with the transmission of primary and/or secondary HIV infections of or by this individuals. See attached research protocol for additional detail on the small groups offered.

MSM and Atlanta City Jail and Detention Center agree to abide by all State and Federal laws, rules and regulations respecting the confidentiality of the individual. Both parties agree not to



divulge any information concerning any participant to any unauthorized person without written consent of the individual participant.

Entire Understanding:

This Memorandum of Understanding sets forth the entire arrangement between the parties and supersedes all prior oral and written understandings, representations, and discussions between the parties regarding the subject matter of this letter.

Governing Law:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed by and subject to the laws of the State of Georgia

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have hereunto affixed their signatures on the date indicated to signify their acceptance of this Memorandum of Understanding.


