


**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA ALONG WITH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ATLANTA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (“AWDA”) TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA (“AHA”) FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING AHA-ASSISTED FAMILIES IN MEETING THE AHA CATALYST WORK REQUIREMENT; WAIVING THE GRANT APPLICATIONS PROVISIONS OF SECTION 2-910 OF THE ATLANTA CITY CODE IN ORDER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION TWO-HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND (\$1,250,000) DOLLARS OVER THE NEXT FIVE YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency (“AWDA”) is to serve the citizens of the City of Atlanta (“the City”) by providing employment, job training, career development, job readiness, job placement and other supportive services; and

**WHEREAS**, the AHA requires all non-disabled adults between the ages of 18 and 61 receiving housing assistance from AHA to be engaged in at least thirty (30) hours a week of employment, education and/or job training pursuant to the CATALYST Work Requirement (“CATALYST Requirement”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City is willing to support AHA-assisted families who are not currently in compliance with the CATALYST Requirement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has developed an enhanced program and monitoring system to meet the special needs of AHA-assisted families (“AWDA Program”); and

**WHEREAS**, the AHA-assisted families who are not currently meeting the CATALYST Requirement will be required to attend the AWDA Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement (“Agreement”) with AHA, relating to the services provided by AWDA and AWDA’s strategic partners through a mandatory orientation and the AWDA Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the AHA shall pay the City an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) per term to execute the AWDA Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that the Mayor is authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Housing Authority of the City of Atlanta, Georgia for the purpose of helping AHA-assisted families meet the AHA CATALYST Work Requirement in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) per term;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all expenses shall be charged to and paid from Project, Task, Award, Expenditure, Owning Organization:

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Attorney is directed to prepare an appropriate Agreement for execution of the Mayor.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Agreement will not become binding on the City, and the City will incur no obligation or liability under it until it has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, approved as to form by the City Attorney, and delivered to AHA.
