COUNCILMEMBER KEISHA LANCE BOTTOMS

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE RESCUE, AUTHORIZING FULTON COUNTY TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION, FIRE SUPPRESSION, EMERGENCY MEDICAL, HAZARDOUS MATERIAL, TECHNICAL RESCUE, AND SUPPORT ASSISTANCE IN SPECIFIC AREAS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, WITH THE INITIAL TERM OF THE IGA BEING FOUR (4) MONTHS CONCLUDING ON DECEMBER 31, 2010, WITH THE IGA TO AUTOMATICALLY RENEW ON JANUARY FIRST OF EACH SUCCESSIVE YEAR, AND THAT AS PAYMENT THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ATLANTA SHALL PAY FULTON COUNTY AND ANNUAL AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000.00), WITH ONE HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX DOLLARS AND SIXTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$104,166.67) AS A PRO-RATED AMOUNT PAYABLE UPON THE EXECUTION OF THE IGA, AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR, WITH ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) DUE ON EACH SUCCESSIVE JANUARY FIRST AND ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) DUE ON EACH SUCCESSIVE JULY FIRST; ALL PAYMENTS TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND, ACCOUNT AND CENTER NUMBERS: 1001.230201.5710001.3520000 (PAYMENTS TO OTHER GOVERNMENTS); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

COUNCILMEMBER KEISHA LANCE BOTTOMS

As Amended by Public Safety and Legal Administration Committee

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE RESCUE, AUTHORIZING FULTON COUNTY TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION, FIRE SUPPRESSION, EMERGENCY MEDICAL, HAZARDOUS MATERIAL, TECHNICAL RESCUE, AND SUPPORT ASSISTANCE IN SPECIFIC AREAS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, WITH THE INITIAL TERM OF THE IGA BEING FOUR (4) MONTHS CONCLUDING ON DECEMBER 31, 2010, WITH THE IGA TO AUTOMATICALLY RENEW ON JANUARY FIRST OF EACH SUCCESSIVE YEAR, AND THAT AS PAYMENT THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ATLANTA SHALL PAY FULTON COUNTY AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000.00), WITH ONE HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX DOLLARS AND SIXTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$104,166.67) AS A PRO-RATED AMOUNT PAYABLE UPON THE EXECUTION OF THE IGA, AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR, WITH ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) DUE ON EACH SUCCESSIVE JANUARY FIRST AND ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000.00) DUE ON EACH SUCCESSIVE JULY FIRST; ALL PAYMENTS TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND, ACCOUNT AND CENTER NUMBERS: 1001.230201.5710001.3520000 (PAYMENTS TO OTHER GOVERNMENTS); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta wishes to enter into an intergovernmental agreement, (IGA), with Fulton County, Georgia authorizing Fulton County to automatically respond and provide fire prevention, fire suppression, emergency medical, hazardous material, technical rescue and support services in contiguous geographical service areas within the boundaries of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, these contiguous geographical service areas are as follows: Apollo Drive, Beaver Falls Place, Bethany Forest Drive, Boise Trail, Branford Forest Way, Britain Drive, Cascade Knolls Drive, Cascade Pointe Drive, Cascade Road, Celebration Court, Celebration Drive, Claridge Trace, Danforth Road, East Court Drive, Elysian Drive, Elysian Park, Fern Brooks Drive, Forest Crossing Drive, Forest Overlook Drive, Forest Overlook Trail, Gathering Park Drive, Glenhurst Lane, Green Cup Court, Green Cup Lane, Guilford Forest Drive, Guilford Forest Lane, Hamden Forest Drive, Hamden Forest Trail, I-Hamden Trace, Inspiration Way, Jewel Court, Jewel Drive, Laren Lane, Legacy Place, Legend Court, Melbenan Drive, New Britain Drive, New Haven Court, New Hope Road, Niskey Lake Circle, Niskey Lake Road, Overlook Court, Park Center Drive, Regency Center Drive, Regency Crest Court, Regency Crest Drive, Regency Park Drive,



Rehoboth Circle, Reunion Court, Reunion Place, Shanter Trail, Straton Trace, Twin Tendrils, and Willowood Lane; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the IGA shall be for four months, concluding on December 31, 2010; and the IGA shall automatically renew on January 1 of each successive year unless terminated by either party; and

WHEREAS, for fire and rescue services to be rendered pursuant to the IGA, the City of Atlanta shall pay to Fulton County an annual amount of \$250,000.00, with \$104,166.67 as a pro-rated amount due upon the execution of the IGA which will cover the remaining months of 2010, and for each subsequent year \$125,000.00 due on each successive January 1, and each successive July 1.


THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement, (hereinafter referred to as the "IGA"), with Fulton County, Georgia on behalf of the Department of Fire Rescue, authorizing Fulton County to automatically respond and provide fire prevention, fire suppression, emergency medical, hazardous material, technical rescue and support services in contiguous geographical service areas within the boundaries of the City of Atlanta; and that in exchange therefore the City of Atlanta shall pay to Fulton County an annual amount of \$250,000.00, with \$104,166.67 as a pro-rated amount due upon the execution of the IGA which will cover the remaining months of 2010, and for each subsequent year with \$125,000.00 due on each successive January 1, and each successive July 1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the initial term of the IGA shall be for four months, concluding on December 31, 2010; and that the IGA shall automatically renew on January 1 of each successive year for a term not exceeding fifty (50) years, unless terminated by either party.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney or her/his designee be and is directed to prepare the agreement for execution by the Mayor, and the agreement shall be approved by the City Attorney or her/his designee as to form.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the agreement shall not become binding upon the City and the City shall incur no obligation or liability hereunder until the same has been signed by the Mayor and attested to by the municipal clerk, and delivered to Fulton County, Georgia.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all payments to Fulton County, Georgia under the IGA shall be charged to and paid from fund, account, and center numbers:
