


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH WEITZMAN STUDIOS, INC., TO DEVELOP PUBLIC ART FOR THE WEST END LCI STREETScape PROJECT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED (\$250,000.00); ALL FUNDS WILL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM THE ACCOUNT SEGMENT PTAE0 NUMBERS IDENTIFIED IN THIS RESOLUTION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Whereas, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Office of Cultural Affairs and the Department of Public Works have developed a Public Art project that will integrate into the planned streetscapes project for the West End LCI between Lee Street & Joseph E. Lowery on Ralph David Abernathy Boulevard/ Department of Public Works colored pavers, specialty text pavers and vibrant full-color structural concrete murals that will tell the story of the Historic West End area of Southwest Atlanta, Georgia; and

Whereas, the Office of Cultural Affairs acting in accordance with Ordinance Number 08-O-1884 adopted by the Atlanta City Council on November 17, 2008 and approved by the Mayor on November 24, 2008 that allocates one and one half percent of Capital Bond Funds for the design, purchase and placement of artwork at capital building or renovation sites while working in conjunction with the Department of Public Works has recommended awarding a contractual agreement with Weitzman Studios, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00; and

Whereas, the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs and the Director of the Office of Cultural Affairs has recommended that the contractual agreement for a Public Art venture for the West End LCI Streetscape Project be awarded to Weitzman Studios, Inc., 3413 Windom Road, Brentwood, Maryland 20722 utilizing the processes stipulated by the City of Atlanta Public Art Master Plan to create a "Historic Walk" in the West End community stretching nearly the length of two football fields for a period of one (1) year and two (2) months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Atlanta is authorized to enter into a contractual agreement with Steven Weitzman Studios, Inc. to develop public art for the West End LCI Streetscape project between Lee Street and Lowery on Ralph David Abernathy Boulevard for a duration of not more than one (1) year and two (2) months, in



an amount not to exceed (\$250,000.00) for the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Office of Cultural Affairs.

SECTION 2: That the City Attorney be and is hereby directed to prepare the appropriate contractual agreement for execution by the Mayor and the contractual agreement shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney or her designee.

SECTION 3: That this contractual agreement will not become binding upon the City and the City shall incur no obligation or liability hereunder until the same has been signed by the Mayor and attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to Weitzman Studios, Inc.
