A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN APPROPRIATE RENEWAL NO.1 CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH WAYNE EVANS AUCTION COMPANY, INC., FOR FC-6007007930, AUCTIONEER SERVICES, ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PROCUREMENT; ALL REVENUE GENERATED UNDER THE CONTRACT SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE APPROPRIATE FUND, DEPARTMENT, ACCOUNT AND FUNCTION ACTIVITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (the “City”) solicited quotes and entered into an agreement for FC-6007007930, Auctioneer Services on behalf of the City pursuant to resolution 07-R-1510; and

WHEREAS, the original agreement was for a period of three (3) years with two (2) one-year renewal options at the sole discretion of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has a continuing need for auctioneer services to dispose of surplus property; and

WHEREAS, Wayne Evans will continue to receive compensation in the form of a buyer’s premium of 10% of the unit price of the auction item; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer recommends the execution of Renewal Agreement No.1 for FC-6007007930, Auctioneer Services.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor or his designee be and is hereby authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with Wayne Evans Auction Company, Inc., for FC-6007007930, Auctioneer Services, on behalf of the Department of Procurement, and all revenues generated under the contract shall be deposited into 1001 (General Fund), 110103 (DOP Procurement), 3921001 (Proceeds of Sale of Capital), 1517000 (Purchasing); 5401 (Solid Waste Revenue Fund), 130501 (DPW Solid Waste Administration), 3921001 (Proceeds of Sale of Capital), 4510000 (Solid Waste Administration), 5501 (Airport Revenue Fund), 000002 (Revenue Department), 3921001 (Proceeds of Sale of Capital Balance Sheet), 7101 (Agency Fund), 100101 (DOF Chief Financial Officer), 3139001 (Taxes, State Sales), 1320000 (Chief Executive), 200514 (Sales Tax Collections), 91468 (State Agency Fund 9999) ; and 7101 (Agency Fund), 100101 (DOF Chief Financial Officer), 3934007 (Buyer’s Premium).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the term of the Renewal No.1 agreement with Wayne Evans, shall be for a term of one (1) year with the option to renew for one (1) additional year at the sole discretion of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney be and is hereby directed to prepare the appropriate contractual agreements for execution by the Mayor.



BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the agreement shall not become binding on the City and the City shall incur no liability upon same until such agreement has been executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to the contracting parties.
