**A RESOLUTION BY
TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR A GATEWAY GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00) FROM THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND TO ENTER INTO A RIGHT OF WAY MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR MAINTENANCE SERVICES ALONG PORTIONS OF STATE HIGHWAY 139 AND INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 285 UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips within the Georgia Department of Transportation's ("GDOT") right of way must be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") has expressed an interest in installing landscaping and gateway features along portions of State Highway 139 and Interstate 285 ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, State Highway 139 ("Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, SW") intersects with Interstate Highway 285 ("I-285"), which are both under the control of the Georgia Department of Transportation ("GDOT"); and

WHEREAS, the Project will be installed along the northbound and southbound exit ramps of I-285 at State Highway 139; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to apply for the Georgia Transportation Enhancement grant program ("Gateway grant"), which will provide a fifty thousand dollar (\$50,000.00) grant that will pay for one hundred percent (100%) of the funding of the Project at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Gateway grant, GDOT requires execution of a Right-of-Way Maintenance Agreement that will require the City to maintain the landscaping and gateway features at the I-285 exit ramps at State Highway 139 that are under the control of GDOT; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of the City's acceptance of the Gateway grant, after the installation of the landscaping and gateway features at the I-285 exit ramps at State Highway 139, the City will assign its responsibilities under its maintenance agreement with GDOT for the duration of said agreement to Adamsville Business & Community Partnership, Inc.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to apply to GDOT for a Georgia Transportation Enhancement grant in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into a Right-of-Way Maintenance Agreement (the "Agreement") with the Georgia Department of Transportation for maintenance services for the Project where State Highway 139 intersects with Interstate I-285.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that as a condition of the City's acceptance of the Gateway grant, after the installation of the landscaping and gateway features at the I-285 exit ramps at State Highway 139, the City will assign its responsibilities under its maintenance agreement with GDOT for the duration of said agreement to Adamsville Business & Community Partnership, Inc.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Agreement will not become binding on the City and the City will incur no liability nor obligation under it until it has been approved by the City Attorney as to form, executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk and delivered to the Georgia Department of Transportation.
