AN ORDINANCE BY COUNCILMEMBER YOLANDA ADREAN

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 150-148(b) OF DIVISION 4, "RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING", UNDER ARTICLE IV., CHAPTER 150. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO ALLOW FOR THE CREATION OF A WYCLIFF RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Wycliff Road within the Ardmore Park Neighborhood is located next to a major traffic generator- Piedmont Hospital- and is a block away from the heavily frequented commercial, retail and restaurant establishments along Peachtree Road; and

WHEREAS, many of the residents on Wycliff Road live in older condominium buildings which do not have designated parking therefore they depend on the availability of on-street parking; and

WHEREAS, available on-street parking has become increasingly difficult for residents to find due to the major traffic generators in the area, which led Public Works to approve and administer a temporary residential permit parking program for Wycliff Road; and

WHEREAS, while the temporary residential permit parking program was in place for Wycliff Road amendments to the City's Residential Permit Parking Ordinance were approved by City Council, which included an increase in the block face street requirement from one-block face to two-block faces; and

WHEREAS, although the residents of Wycliff Road, along with Public Works, have explored every option to meet the two-block face requirement it proves to be almost impossible being that the streets abutting Wycliff either prohibit parking due to the classification of the street, as is the case for Collier Road, or in the case of 28th Street, have current "no parking" restrictions in place that were legislated over 20 years ago; and

WHEREAS, due to the current parking restrictions on both streets abutting Wycliff Road an exemption to the two-block face requirement is the only viable option in order for Wycliff to qualify for a residential permit parking program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Department of Public Works provide an exemption from the two-block face street requirement under Section 150-148(b) of Division 4. "Residential Permit Parking" Ordinance for the proposed Wycliff Road Residential Permit Parking program.



SECTION 2: That the Department of Public Works only apply the exemption to the two-block face street requirement and that Wycliff Road must meet all other requirements of the program under Division 4. "Residential Permit Parking", Article IV, Chapter 150 in order to qualify for a permanent residential permit parking program.

SECTION 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed for purposes of this ordinance only, and only to the extent of the conflict.
