AN ORDINANCE EXPRESSING THE ATLANTA CITY COUNCIL'S SUPPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL LITERACY PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO ACCEPT MONETARY AND IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL LITERACY PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO CREATE A TRUST FUND ACCOUNT ON BEHALF OF COUNCIL DISTRICT 11 FOR THE DEPOSIT OF MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF ATLANTA IN CONNECTION WITH THE ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL LITERACY PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, City of Atlanta District 11 Council Member Keisha Lance Bottoms, will introduce The Economic and Financial Literacy Program which is designed to take children far beyond money management skills. This program is specifically designed to equip today's youth with the necessary critical economic thinking tools needed for tomorrow's economy. One of the goals of this program is to teach children how to build true wealth and start legacies; and

WHEREAS, The Economic and Financial Literacy Program will offer workshops and courses on financial literacy, fun-filled exercises, and hands-on activities. This program will allow the children to embrace critical thinking and creative thought, while putting wealth building at the forefront of financial endeavors; and

WHEREAS, The Economic and Financial Literacy Program will empower children by transforming their mindset from chasing money to a mindset of wealth; understanding wealth as a birthright; discovering their dreams and passion; and the understanding to make sound financial decisions; and

WHEREAS, The Economic and Financial Literacy Program will educate children through exploring traditional and non-traditional ways of building wealth; and

WHEREAS, The Economic and Financial Literacy Program goal is to equip children with the necessary tools for financial empowerment through education

and money management, which will create a bridge to the financial world that surrounds them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1: The Atlanta City Council hereby expresses its support of The Economic and Financial Literacy Program.

SECTION 2: The City of Atlanta is hereby authorized to accept monetary and in-kind contributions for The Economic and Financial Literacy Program.

SECTION 3: The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to create a trust fund account on behalf of Council District 11 for the deposit of monetary contributions received by the City of Atlanta in connection with The Economic and Financial Literacy Program.

SECTION 4: The Economic and Financial Literacy Program shall remain in effect until terminated by action of the Atlanta City Council.

SECTION 5: The created trust fund account shall remain in effect until terminated by action of the Atlanta City Council or the end of the four-year legislative term.

SECTION 6: That any residual funds in the Trust Fund Account and/or in-kind contributions remaining after the end of The Economic and Financial Literacy Program will be donated to the Centers of Hope in City of Atlanta Council District 11.

SECTION 7: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby waived.
