**A RESOLUTION BY FINANCE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT WITH CDW GOVERNMENT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2-1602 AND 2-1604 OF THE PROCUREMENT AND REAL ESTATE CODE OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, UTILIZING THE GSA CONTRACT# GS-35F-0195J, FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTERS AND SCANNERS ON BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF ATLANTA, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED NINETY-EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$198,548); ALL COSTS TO BE CHARGED TO: FUND, DEPARTMENT, ACCOUNT, AND FUNCTION ACTIVITY: 1001 (GENERAL FUND), 190101 (MUNICIPAL COURT OPERATIONS), 5222002 (REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE), 2650000 (MUNICIPAL COURTS); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta ("City") Municipal Court desires to enter into a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with CDW Government, for the purpose of purchasing computers and scanners; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Sections 2-1602 and 2-1604 of the Procurement and Real Estate Code of the City of Atlanta, which authorizes Cooperative Purchasing Agreements between governmental agencies and public procurement units for the procurement of supplies, services, or construction items through contracts established by the purchasing division of the Federal Government, where such contractors substantially meet the requirements of this article; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Judge and the Procurement Commissioner have recommended utilizing GSA Contract# GS-35F-0195J with CDW Government for the purchase of computers and scanners.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES** that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to utilize GSA Contract# GS-35F-0195J with CDW Government for the purchase of computers and scanners, on behalf of the Municipal Court of Atlanta, in an amount not to exceed one hundred ninety-eight thousand five hundred forty-eight dollars (\$198,548).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Procurement Commissioner be and is hereby directed to prepare the appropriate Agreement.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Agreement shall not become binding upon the City, and the City shall incur no obligation or liability upon same until contract has been executed by the Mayor and delivered to the contracting party.



**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that all costs shall be charged to: 1001 (General Fund), 190101 (Municipal Court Operations), 5222002 (Repair and Maintenance), 2650000 (Municipal Courts).
