

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENTS OF HUMAN RESOURCES, FINANCE AND CORRECTIONS STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF RETURNING DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS EMPLOYEES TO EIGHT-HOUR SHIFTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS,** The Department of Corrections (DoC) moved its staff to 12-hour shifts in December 2008; and,

**WHEREAS,** DoC is an Atlanta Police Department (APD) Service Support Agency; and,

**WHEREAS,** APD continues to work on three eight-hour shifts a day; and,

**WHEREAS,** When Atlanta Police Officers deliver detainees to the City's Detention Center they are often subject to long waits while Corrections personnel complete shift changes; and

**WHEREAS,** During said shift changes, Atlanta Police Officers are unavailable for their patrol duties, thereby decreasing police availability and responsiveness.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** That the Departments of Human Resources, Finance and Corrections study the feasibility of returning Department of Corrections employees to eight-hour shifts.

**SECTION 2:** That said study is presented to the City Council within 180 days of the adoption of this resolution.

**SECTION 3:** That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed.
