A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 10-R-0926 AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A COMMISSION TO DETERMINE AN APPROPRIATE HONOR FOR THE COMMITTEE FOR THE APPEAL FOR HUMAN RIGHTS AND THE ATLANTA STUDENT MOVEMENT SO AS TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION TO APPOINT ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION REPRESENTING ENTITIES AND ORGANIZATIONS WHICH CAN EITHER BENEFIT FROM OR CONTRIBUTE TO THE MISSION , GOALS AND WORKS OF THE COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Resolution 10-R-0926 was adopted by the council on June 7, 2010; and


WHEREAS, members of the Commission desire to appoint associate members to the Commission who represent entities which can either benefit from or contribute to the mission, goal and works of the commission; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City council is supportive of the desires of the commission members to appoint such associate members to the Commission.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:
