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
FOLLOW-UP ITEMS (CONT'D)

2. Councilmember Young requested that David Bennett make a report to the committee relating to the Vending contract every two weeks.
3. Councilmember Young requested the Law Department to find out from Park Atlanta:
 1. Does Park Atlanta have any vacancy positions?
 2. What are they doing to fill those positions?

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There being no further business to come before the Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 4:31 p.m.


