A RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS CREATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR CITIZENS TO PETITION THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO CREATE OR CHANGE PARKING METER ZONES PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED ACCORDING TO CHAPTER 150, ARTICLE IV OF THE ATLANTA CITY CODE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta ("City") has implemented certain changes to its on-street parking meter program to facilitate the efficient operation of metered parking to benefit residents, business owners, visitors, patrons of the arts and all members of the public; and

WHEREAS, the City has created a city-wide parking management system which allows metered parking in four defined areas throughout the city known as "zones" such that the hours of parking enforcement and parking time limits in each zone conform to the needs of the zoned areas; and

WHEREAS, the four types of zones as set out at Atlanta City Code of Ordinances at Section 150-132(a) are (1) business/government; (2) mixed use; (3) school/university; and (4) entertainment/restaurant/hospital; and

WHEREAS, within said designated zones, there may be certain street segments that may have the characteristics of one of the other three established zones; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has established an administrative procedure that permits the residents and/or businesses within said certain street segments to petition the City to change or create a new parking zone with more appropriate parking time limits and hours of enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Atlanta agrees to and approves of the creation of parking zones based on the administrative procedures established by the Department of Public Works.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the administrative procedure for the creation or change of parking zones established by the Department of Public Works, outlined below, is agreed to and approved by the Council:

Administrative Process for Parking Zone Changes

1. A citizen shall notify the City of Atlanta's Parking Management Team of the requested change via a letter or email sent to parkingfeedback@atlantaga.gov.
2. Once the request is received by the Parking Management Team, a site visit will be scheduled with PARKatlanta and the affected community to discuss the feasibility of making the change to the street segment.



3. A petition must be distributed to the affected residents and businesses and based on one vote per address, at least 70% of the affected residents and businesses must be in support of the proposal.
4. The petition must include any adjoining businesses.
5. For zone changes to the Mixed Use Zone, residents must reside in a building with one or less parking spaces per unit.
6. Once all criteria have been satisfied, the Department of Public Works will review the application and petition form to determine approval. If approved, the Department of Public Works and PARKatlanta will provide a timeline for implementing the change.
7. Citizens will be notified once changes have been completed.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Department of Public Works shall be responsible for providing the administrative process for parking zone changes in written form to the public, along with an application, petition form, and a checklist of instructions.
