A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE TEMPORARY SERVICE CONTRACTS WITH TWO (2) RETIRED CITY OF ATLANTA FIRE OFFICERS, ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE RESCUE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FIREFIGHTING, EMERGENCY MEDICAL, AND SPECIAL OPERATIONS TRAINING AT THE ATLANTA FIRE TRAINING ACADEMY FOR A PERIOD OF TWELVE (12) MONTHS, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HUNDRED AND SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$106,000.00), ALL COSTS TO BE CHARGED AND PAID FROM FUND – 1001, DEPARTMENT – 230102, ACCOUNT – 5212001, FUNCTION ACTIVITY – 3510000; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Department of Fire Rescue Training Academy is required to deliver 141,146 training hours annually for its sworn members; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Fire Rescue Training Academy existing training staff can only deliver approximately 86,400 training hours; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Fire Rescue Training Academy has a 55,046 hour training deficit with its existing training staff; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Fire Rescue has determine that it will be beneficial to utilized retired Fire Officers to assist its training staff in accomplish its required training hours; and

WHEREAS, the retired Fire Officers possess the knowledge and expertise to provide the necessary firefighting, emergency medical, and special operations training; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Fire Rescue has to train approximately 180 new recruits within a two year period; and

WHEREAS, such engagements are authorized pursuant to Part I, Article 3, Chapter 5, Section 3-505 of the Charter of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, such engagements shall comply with the provisions of Part I, Chapter 6, Article IV, Division 1, Section 6-386 of the Charter of the City of Atlanta related to the re-employment of pensioners in the City of Atlanta Firefighters' Pension Fund.



**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, HEREBY
RESOLVES THE FOLLOWING:**

Section 1: That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute contracts, on behalf of the Department of Fire Rescue, with two (2) retired fire officers for the purpose of providing firefighting, emergency medical, and special operations training at the Atlanta Fire Training Academy,


Section 2: In an amount not to exceed one-hundred and six thousand dollars and zero cents (\$106,000.00), and all contracted work shall be charged to and paid from Fund Account – 1001, Department – 230101, Account – 5212001, Function Activity – 351000

Section 3: The contracts shall be approved by the City Attorney or his/her designee as to form.

Section 4: The Agreement shall not become binding upon the City and the City shall incur no obligation or liability hereunder until the same has been signed by the Mayor or his designee and delivered to the respective retired City of Atlanta Fire Officers.

Section 5: That all resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are repealed.

AGREEMENT

GEORGIA.....CITY OF ATLANTA

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into as of the _____ day of _____ 2011, by _____ and between the **CITY OF ATLANTA**, a municipal corporation of the State of Georgia (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), and _____ of _____ (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor")

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the "Contractor" retired as a Fire Officer in the Fire Department of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Chief of Fire desire to utilize the skills and expertise of the "Contractor" to provide firefighting, emergency medical, and special operations training at the Atlanta Fire Rescue Training Academy; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has certified the necessity of such contractual agreement in compliance with the requirements of Section 3-505 of the Charter of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the execution of this agreement, on the part of the "City" has been authorized by Resolution # _____, adopted by the City Council, and approved by the Mayor, in the form and manner of that copy of the same attached hereto as Appendix 1 and made a part hereof by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the premises and mutual covenants hereinafter contained, it is agreed between the parties hereto as follows:

1.

The "Contractor" agrees to provide firefighting, emergency medical, and special operations training to the Department of Fire Rescue members at the Atlanta Fire Rescue Training Academy.

2.

In consideration of such services, the "City" agrees to pay compensation to the "Contractor" to be computed at a rate of \$22.50 per hour, for a total not to exceed \$ _____, over the term of this contract, to be paid from Account No. 1001.230101.5212001.3510000



3.

The term of this agreement shall commence on _____, and shall continue thereafter for a period of twelve (12) months; provided, however, that either party upon ten (10) business days prior written notice to the other may terminate this agreement.

4.

The "Contractor" agrees that the services hereunder shall not constitute reemployment by the "City" and the "Contractor" shall not acquire any civil service rights, employee benefits, or any further pension rights by virtue of this Agreement. The "City" agrees that "Contractor" shall be entitled to continue to receive his/her regular pension payments, and that he/she will not be required to make any contributions to the pension fund by virtue of this Agreement.

5.

The parties agree that the term of this Agreement, as set forth herein, shall constitute the entire agreement between them. Changes, which may be mutually agreed upon be and between the "City and "Consultant" shall be effective e and enforceable only after both parties, hereto, have executed a written amendment.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City, acting by and through its duty authorized officials, and the "Contractor" has executed this Agreement as of this day and year first above written.
