**A RESOLUTION BY
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT/HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO PARTICIPATE WITH PARK PRIDE ATLANTA, INC., IN PERFORMING CERTAIN MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR WORK AT ADAMS PARK, BY PROVIDING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000.00 TOWARD THE PROJECT WHICH SHALL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM THE GROUND AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS TRUST ACCOUNT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (“City”) owns the 158-acre Adams Park located at 2300 Wilson Drive, SW, Atlanta (the “Park”); and

WHEREAS, the Park is an important location the offers recreational activities to residents of southwest Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the picnic and pond areas of the Park have been degraded from ongoing erosion and poor drainage in the area. Continued erosion may lead to an unsafe pedestrian environment, expose service lines and collapse the foundation of the picnic pavilion; and

WHEREAS, Park Pride Atlanta, Inc. (“Park Pride”), is a non-profit organization with whom the City contracts to handle coordination of in-kind donations for City parks, and to act as a fiduciary agent for donated funds dedicated to park improvement and repair; and

WHEREAS, Park Pride has been working with the local community to develop a Vision Plan for the Park and assist in mobilizing a large community effort and fundraising resources; and

WHEREAS, Park Pride and the community have raised \$300,000.00, and are committed to raising an additional \$50,000.00 to be allocated towards site improvements in the area of the picnic pavilion and pond area at the Park; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs (“DPRCA”) desires to participate in the Project by providing \$200,000.00 to the Project from the Ground & Site Improvement Trust (the “Trust”). The funds in the Trust must be utilized for Park landscaping repairs, capital improvements, other site improvements, and any other repairs or maintenance work approved in writing by the DPRCA Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, the City is appreciative of the contributions of Park Pride and the Adams Park community, and finds that it is in the City’s best interest to accept the contribution and dedicate funds from the Trust account to improve the Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor, on behalf of the City, is hereby authorized to pay an amount not to exceed \$200,000 to Park Pride Atlanta, Inc., to be used solely for the Project, and specifically to




fund renovations to the picnic pavilion and pond area or any portion thereof as designated in writing by the DPRCA Commissioner.

SECTION 2: All fund utilized pursuant to Section 1 above shall be charged to and paid from Account Segment Numbers:

SECTION 3: The City hereby accepts the contributions of Park Pride Atlanta, Inc., namely the Park improvements and the monetary cost thereof.
