A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING SUSAN MCNEILL MENDHEIM FOR HER COMMITMENT AND DEDICATED PUBLIC SERVICE TO THE ENHANCEMENT OF THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN MIDTOWN ATLANTA FOR THE PAST 30 YEARS; AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A PLAQUE IN RECOGNITION OF HER AT THE 15th STREET PLAZA; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Susan McNeill Mendheim has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours, talents, and energy toward the betterment of her Midtown community and city as evidenced by her 30 years of superlative service with the Midtown Alliance; and

WHEREAS, as President and CEO of Midtown Alliance, Ms. Mendheim has led efforts to transform Midtown Atlanta from a blighted, crime-ridden area into a vibrant and vital community, which enjoys a growing reputation as a model for new urbanism and economic growth; and

WHEREAS, under her leadership, Midtown Alliance launched the community-wide planning effort, Blueprint Midtown, an award-winning plan that has generated over \$1.5 billion in private investment, 11,500 new residential units, nine million square feet of office space, and over 600,000 square feet of retail space; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mendheim was also responsible for the creation of a Midtown Improvement District, which enables commercial property owners to tax themselves to pay for specific initiatives to include a 24-hour private police force, an environmental maintenance program, and a transportation management association; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mendheim has been recognized with numerous honors and accolades, including the Dan Sweat Community Leadership Award from ULI/Atlanta, the Civic Leadership Award from the Building Owners and Managers Association, and a Most Influential Atlantan by the Atlanta Business Chronicle; and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this remarkable and distinguished Atlantan be recognized with a plaque to be located in the 15th Street Arts District Plaza.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:




SECTION 1: That the Atlanta City Council hereby recognizes and commends Susan McNeill Mendheim for her commitment and dedicated public service to the enhancement of the quality of life in Midtown Atlanta for the past 30 years.

SECTION 2: That the Midtown Alliance is authorized to install a plaque at the 15th Street Plaza in recognition of Susan McNeill Mendheim.

SECTION 3: That the installation and on-going maintenance and operation of said plaque shall be the responsibility of Midtown Alliance.


