A RESOLUTION

BY COUNCILMEMBER MICHAEL JULIAN BOND as amended by Full Council

A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A COMPREHENSIVE ONE-STOP ONLINE RESOURCE ADDRESSING THE NEEDS OF ATLANTA'S AT-RISK YOUTH; TO PROVIDE THAT THE ONLINE YOUTH RESOURCE PAGE IS INCORPORATED INTO THE CITY OF ATLANTA'S OFFICIAL WEBSITE; TO ACCEPT THE OFFER OF THE PRESIDENT'S WHITE HOUSE COUNCIL FOR COMMUNITY SOLUTIONS TO PROVIDE A LINK FROM ITS WEBSITE TO THE CITY'S YOUTH RESOURCE PAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, On December 14, 2010, President Barack Obama signed an Executive Order establishing the White House Council for Community Solutions to engage a diverse group of prominent cross-sector leaders to: identify successful community change; honor and highlight individuals and institutions implementing such change; provide resources to engage citizens in their own communities; learn key attributes of effective cross-sector solutions; and to support and promote successful approaches; and,

WHEREAS, Currently, less than half of young Americans have the education, training and skills needed to compete in today's workforce by age 25; and,

WHEREAS, The White House Council is conducting youth listening sessions throughout the country to identify solutions to help at-risk youth succeed; and,

WHEREAS, On May 13, 2011, hosted at Atlanta's Goodwill Career Center, White House Council for Community Solutions Board Chairman Jon Bon Jovi, Chris Kids, Visions Youth Leadership Academy, City Councilmember Michael Julian Bond and Chief Service Officer for the City of Atlanta Amy Phuong attended the country's second youth listening session; and,

WHEREAS, Youth expressed difficulty in finding, and a desire for, a complete and comprehensive online resource that provides relevant and current information regarding: ageing out of foster care - applying for a social security card, retrieving birth records, housing, medical services, and other social services; and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City of Atlanta to provide such information.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:


SECTION 1: That a comprehensive one-stop online resource addressing the needs of Atlanta's at-risk youth is created and is linked up with conjunction with the Fulton County Family and Children Services and with United Way through its Help Book.

SECTION 2: That said online resource page is incorporated into the City of Atlanta's official website.



SECTION 3: That the resulting web page will be directly linked to the White House Council for Community Solutions website.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby waived to the extent of the conflict.
