A RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING JUNE 27, 2011 AS NATIONAL HIV TESTING DAY; AND SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS OF THE WORLD CONFERENCE OF MAYORS AND THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PEOPLE WITH AIDS (NAPWA) TO EDUCATE THE PUBLIC AS REGARDS HIV/AIDS PREVENTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The City Council joins the National Association of People with AIDS (NAPWA) in recognizing June 27, 2011 as National HIV Testing Day; and

WHEREAS, This year begins the fourth decade of America's HIV/AIDS pandemic. It was just thirty years ago on June 5, 1981, that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported a cluster of PCP pneumonia cases – the first documented cases of what we now call AIDS; and

WHEREAS, Today, the CDC estimates approximately 21 percent of the 1.3 million Americans living with HIV are unaware of their HIV status. The CDC now recommends that medical providers offer all persons ages 13 to 64 HIV testing as a routine part of medical care; and

WHEREAS, Early HIV diagnosis is critical so that people infected with the virus can fully benefit from available life-saving treatments. Currently, almost 40 percent of people with HIV are not diagnosed until they already have developed AIDS; and

WHEREAS, Today rapid HIV testing technology is readily available and easy to use, such that results can be delivered in just 20 minutes; and

WHEREAS, National HIV Testing Day is an opportunity to raise awareness and commit to marshalling resources to end this pandemic and to reaffirm our compassion for those who need our help in the struggle against HIV.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the City Council joins the National Association of People with AIDS (NAPWA) in recognizing June 27, 2011 as National HIV Testing Day

SECTION 2: That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are and the same is hereby repealed.
