RESOLUTION

BY COUNCILMEMBER JOYCE M. SHEPERD

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 11-R-0770 SO AS TO ADD A NEW MEMBER TO THE TIRE COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council adopted on May 16, 2011, the attached Resolution 11-R-0770 to create a Tire Commission to study ways to manage illegal tire dumping, increase the city's code enforcement and suggest language to amend the existing City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Service Officer from the Mayor's Office and the Office of Code Compliance shall provide the technical and administrative support for the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council wishes to expand the Tire Commission with an additional member from the Mayor's Office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 1 in Resolution 11-R-0770 is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Section 1, which shall read as follows:

"SECTION 1: That a Tire Commission is hereby created with **eleven (11)** members to be appointed as follows:

- a. One member from the Community Development and Human Resources Committee
- b. Citizen Advocate from the Mayor's Office**
- c. One member appointed by Atlanta Planning Advisory Board (APAB)
- d. A representative from Atlanta Clean City Commission
- e. One member from the State Environmental Protection Division (EPD)
- f. One member from the Fulton County Health Department
- g. Director of Code Compliance or his designee
- h. Director of Solid Waste Services or his designee
- i. A city attorney designated by Atlanta City Attorney
- j. A staff person designated by the Police Chief
- k. A staff person from the City Courts/Community Prosecutor"

SECTION 2: All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed for purposes of the resolutions only, and only to the extent of the conflict.
