



**ORDINANCE BY COMMITTEE ON COUNCIL**

**TO AMEND THE 2001 CITY OF ATLANTA PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES IN PRECINCTS 02C, 03C, 03G, 04G, 04V, 06A, 07N, 08C, 08H, 08J, 09A, 09F, 11J and 11N TO MAKE PERMANENT RELOCATIONS AS A RESULT OF COMPLETED RENOVATIONS, INADEQUATE HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING ISSUES AT EXISTING FACILITIES; SAFETY ISSUES AND NAME CHANGES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the 2001 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance, dated October 24, 2001, was adopted November 5, 2001, and;

**WHEREAS**, such Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance has previously been amended by action of the City Council on May 20 2002, July 15 2002, September 3 2002, October 21 2002, November 18 2002, September 15 2003, October 20 2003, April 19 2004, July 19 2004, November 01 2004, September 06 2005, November 07 2005, June 05 2006, July 05 2006, September 05 2006, October 02 2006, December 04 2006, February 05 2007, March 19 2007, May 21 2007, September 04 2007, January 22 2008, July 07 2008, November 03 2008, May 04 2009, June 01 2009, August 17 2009, October 19 2009, May 03 2010, November 01 2010 and;

**WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections has approved changes to City of Atlanta Precincts/Polling Places 02C, 03C, 03G, 04G, 04V, 06A, 07N, 08C, 08H, 08J, 09A, 09F, 11J and 11N to make permanent relocations as a result of completed renovations, inadequate heating and air conditioning issues at existing facilities; safety issues and name changes, and;

**WHEREAS**, all affected voters will be notified of these changes by the Fulton County Office of Registration and Elections accordingly, and;

**WHEREAS**, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council, believes that ratification of these changes should be made by this Body.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization and approval by the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections of polling place changes in Precincts **02C, 03C, 03G, 04G, 04V, 06A, 07N, 08C, 08H, 08J, 09A, 09F, 11J and 11N** within the City of Atlanta/Fulton County; and

**BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED** that the Atlanta City Council does hereby Amend the 2001 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance, dated October 24, 2001, and Adopted November 5, 2001 which was codified as Section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances and adopted by reference, by adding the recent changes to Precincts/Polling Places **02C, 03C, 03G, 04G, 04V, 06A, 07N, 08C, 08H, 08J, 09A, 09F, 11J and 11N** to make permanent relocations as a result of completed renovations, inadequate heating and air conditioning issues at existing facilities; safety issues and name changes, all of which are reflected or incorporated in the July 18, 2011 Revision



to the 2001 Precincts and Polling Places Ordinance, identified as Attachment I to this ordinance, with certain particular changes described by the further attachments identified as, **Exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L and M** all being made a part hereof and noted as follows:

**SECTION 1.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 02C located at Grace United Methodist Church, 458 Ponce De Leon Avenue, NE** by moving said precinct back to its original polling place, **Cosby Spears High Rise, 355 North Avenue, NE** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit A (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is .5 miles from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 3). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 2.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 03C located at Anderson Park, 98 Anderson Avenue, NW** by moving said precinct back to its original polling place, **Turner Middle School, 98 Anderson Avenue, NW** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit B (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and located on the same premises as the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 5). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 3.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 03G located at Allen Hickman Student Center, 643 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, SW** by permanently moving said precinct to **Simpson Street Church of Christ, 800 Joseph E. Boone, Blvd., NW** due to chronic problems with inadequate heat and air conditioning as identified in Exhibit C (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is approximately 1.3 miles from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 6). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 4.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 04G located at Faith Church of God in Christ, 1137 Avon Avenue, SW** by changing said precinct to its correct name **Cathedral of Faith Church C.O.G.I.C.** as identified in Exhibit D (Pages 1-2). The new polling place name change is indicated in Attachment I (page 8). Voters will be notified of their voting location name change by first-class mail.

**SECTION 5.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 04V located at City View at Rosa Burney Park, 259 Richardson Street, SW** by permanently moving said precinct to **Dunbar Neighborhood Center, 477 Windsor Street, SW** due to chronic problems with heating and safety issues at the existing facility as identified in Exhibit E (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is approximately .1 mile from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 9). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 6.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 06A located at Grady High School, 929 Charles Allen Drive, NE** by moving said precinct back to its original polling place, **Tenth Street High Rise, 150 Tenth Street, NE** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit F (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is approximately .5 miles from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 12). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.



**SECTION 7.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 07N located at Country Inn & Suites, 800 Sidney Marcus Blvd., NE** by moving said precinct back to its original polling place, **Marian Road High Rise Apt., 760 Sidney Marcus, Blvd., NE** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit G (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is approximately .4 miles from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 15). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 8.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 08C located at W. T. Jackson Primary School, 4191 Northside Drive, NW** by moving said precinct back to its original polling place, **Northwest Presbyterian Church, 4300 Northside Drive, NW** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit H (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is less than 1 mile from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 16). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 9.** To amend **Precincts/Polling Place 08H and 08J located at Northside United Methodist Church, 2799 Northside Drive, NW** by moving said split precincts back to their original polling place, **North Atlanta High School, 2875 Northside Drive, NW** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit I (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is less than one mile from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (Pages 16-17). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 10.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 09A located at Bolton Academy Elementary School, 2268 Adams Drive, NW** by moving said precinct back to its original polling place, **Marietta Road High Rise, 2295 Marietta Road, NW** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit J (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is approximately .5 miles from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 18). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

**SECTION 11.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 09F located at Pace Academy Athletic Facility, 2465 Warren Road, NW** by changing the name of said precinct to **Warren Athletic Field** as identified in Exhibit K (Pages 1-2). The new polling place name change is indicated in Attachment I (page 18). Voters will be notified of their voting location name change by first-class mail.

**SECTION 12.** To amend **Precinct/Polling Place 11J located at God's Church International Fellowship, 3243 Stone Road, SW** by moving said precinct back to its original polling place, **Continental Colony Elementary School, 3181 Hogan Road, SW** due to renovations being completed as identified in Exhibit L (Pages 1-2). The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is less than 1 mile from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 23). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.

The proposed facility is accessible to the disabled and is .6 miles from the existing facility. The new polling place is indicated in Attachment I (page 24). Voters will be notified of their voting location by first-class mail.









# FIGURE 12 EXISTING & PROPOSED POLLING PLACE 07N







**POLLING PLACE 09F**





