

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A NEW DIVISION 3 (TO BE ENTITLED "STREET FOOD VENDING PROGRAM") OF ARTICLE XXIII ("VENDING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY") OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA WHICH DIVISION SHAL PROVIDE THE REGULATORY FRAMEWORK BY WHICH STREET FOOD VENDING IN THE CITY OF ATLANTA SHALL BE GOVERNED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE CREATION OF STREET FOOD VENDING SITES, RULES AND REGULATIONS AND THE CRITERIA FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND THE COST THEREOF; TO WAIVE CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND CODE PROVISIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the street food vending movement is gaining momentum worldwide and nationally; and

WHEREAS, major cities in the United States such as Los Angeles, San Francisco, New York, Portland, Seattle, Washington, DC, Austin, and Minneapolis have embraced this relatively new food service concept and phenomenon; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Atlanta believes it is in the best interest of the city, its citizens and its visitors to modify its laws, ordinances and regulations so as to more easily accommodate the concept of street food vending.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: A new Division 3 (to be entitled "Street Food Vending Program") of Article XXIII ("Vending on Public Property") of the Code of Ordinances of the city of Atlanta, Georgia, is hereby created, which shall provide as follows:

"Division 3. Street Food Vending Program

Sec. 30-1437. Definitions.

Motor vehicle vending means the use of any motorized vehicle, approved by the department of police and used by a lawfully permitted vendor for the purpose of vending food prepared on site at designated and approved locations on city streets or other public right of ways.

Sec. 30-1438. Street food vending program locations.

(a) Four (4) vending locations on the north curbside lane of Edgewood Avenue between Jesse Hill Avenue and Fort Street NE beneath the I-75/85 viaduct;

- (b) Four (4) vending locations on the south curbside lane of Edgewood Avenue between Jesse Hill Avenue and Fort Street NE beneath the I-75/85 viaduct;
- (c) All future street food vending locations shall be reviewed and approved by the city bureau of traffic and transportation and the Atlanta City Council by way of amendment to this ordinance.

Sec. 30-1439. Assignment of vendor sites.

Vendor sites shall be assigned pursuant to a monthly lottery conducted by the license and permits division of the police department. The license and permits division of the police department shall develop, implement and manage the lottery system by which vendor sites shall be assigned.

Sec. 30-1440. Requirements applicable to street food vending.

State and county health approval

Sec. 30-1441. Restrictions on vending locations and operations.

Sec. 30-1442. Public vending management program.

Street food vendors and vending locations shall not be subject to the city's public vending management program.

Sec. 30-1443. Days and hours of operation of vendor stations.

Sec. 30-1444. Permit fees.

Sec. 30-1445. Applicability of code sections 30-1400 through 30-1436.

All provision contained in code sections 30-1400 through 30-1436 which are not inconsistent with the provisions contained in code sections 30-1437 through 30-1443 shall be applicable to the street food vending program.
